

Homelessness bulletin

This report is produced using CLG data, and is updated every 3 months. The CLG data is provided by every district / borough across the country via the P1E form, which they are required to complete. It also draws on annual rough sleeper counts and estimates.

This report focusses on our local area & covers Cambridge, Fenland, East Cambs, Huntingdonshire, South Cambs, Forest Heath, St Edmundsbury and Peterborough. If available, data is included for the whole of England for comparison.

Sources of data are provided at the end of the sheet.

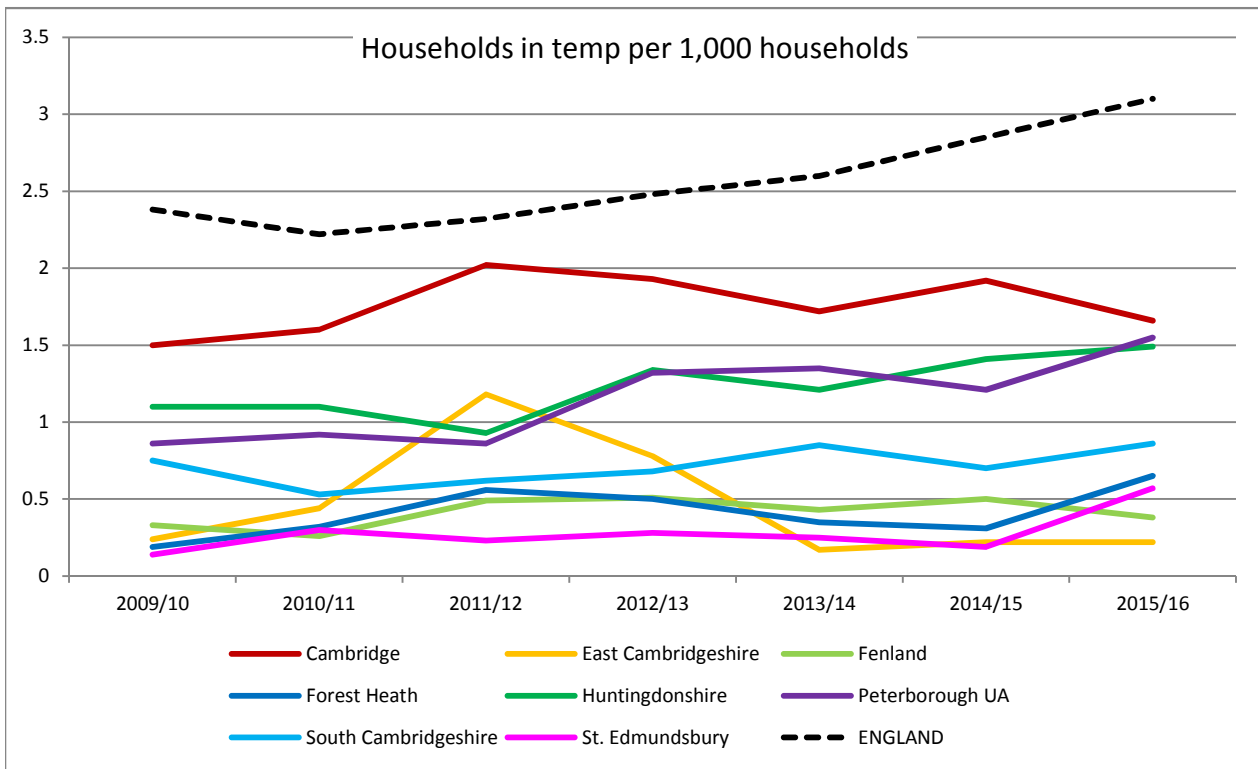
