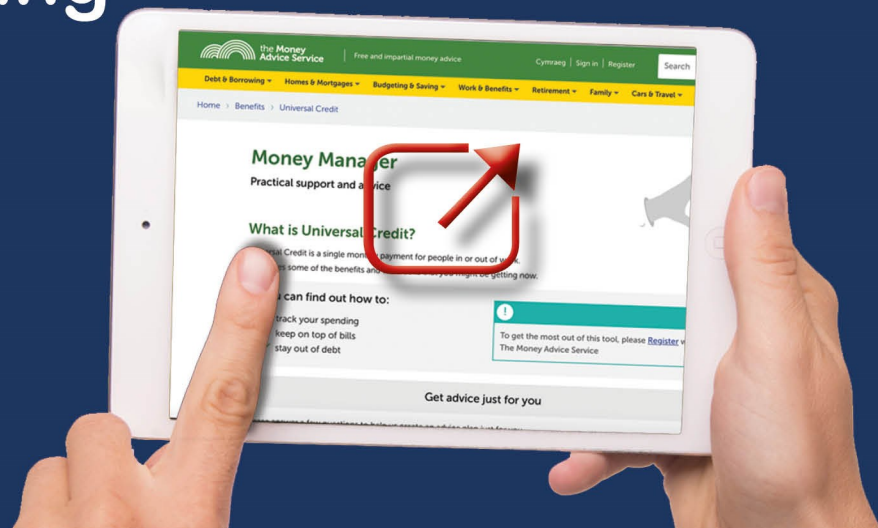

Universal Credit - the changes that may affect how you manage your everyday money.

- ▶ Universal Credit is paid once a month, usually into your [bank, building society or credit union account](#)
- ▶ You will get a single payment for your household
- ▶ If your Universal Credit payment includes housing costs (for example rent) you will need to pay this to your landlord yourself
- ▶ You might have to wait up to five weeks for your first payment
