You can only use GOV.UK Verify when you need to access one of the following services.

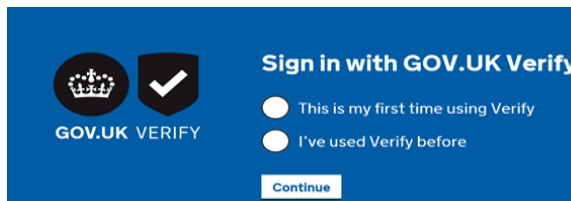
- [Report a medical condition that affects your driving](#), with the Driver and Vehicle Licensing Agency (DVLA)

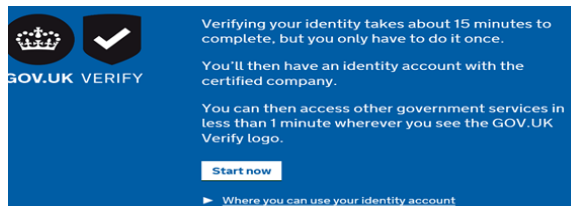
### GOV.UK Verify
