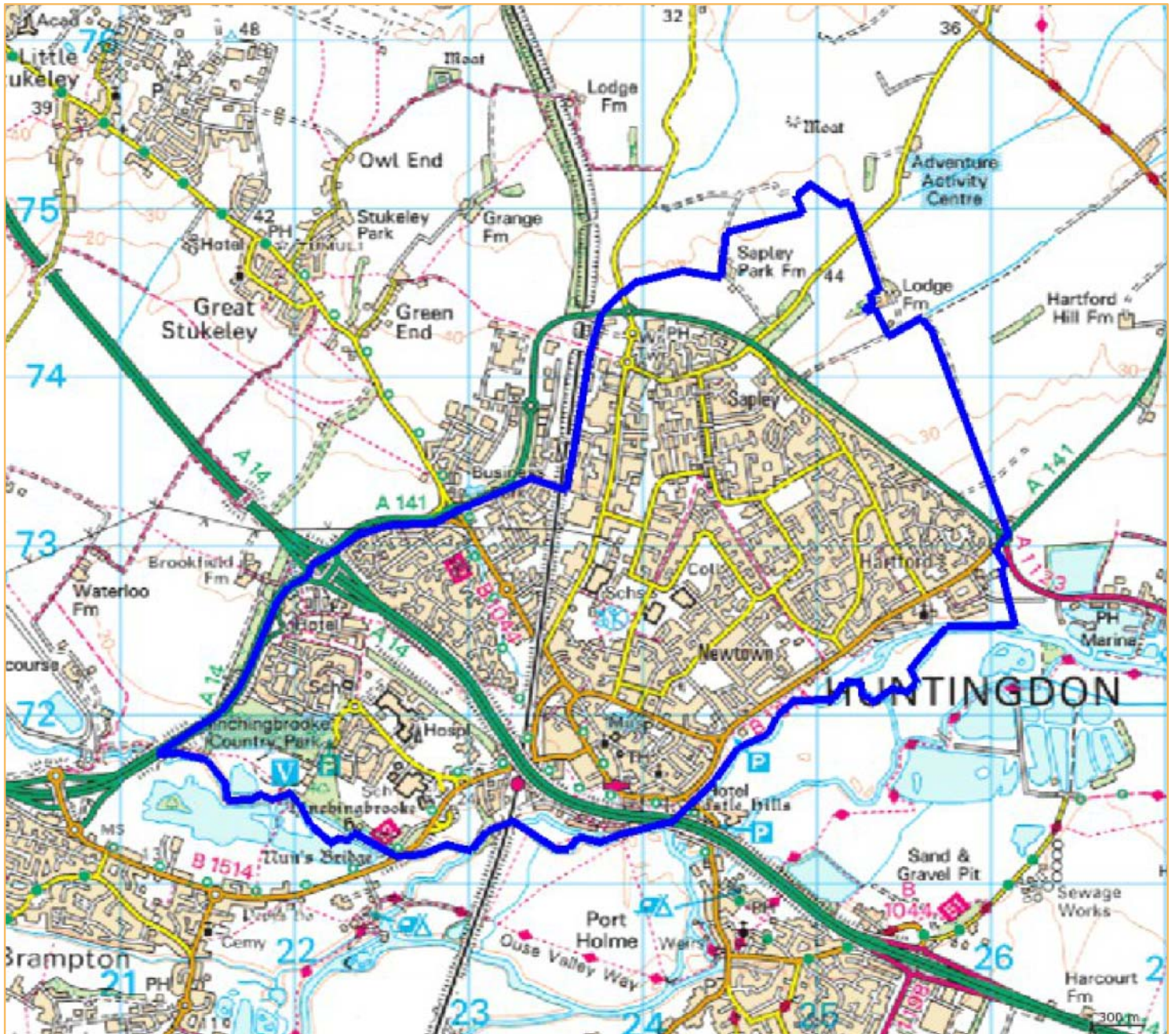

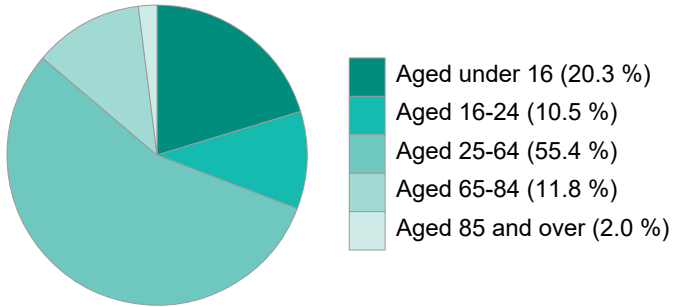

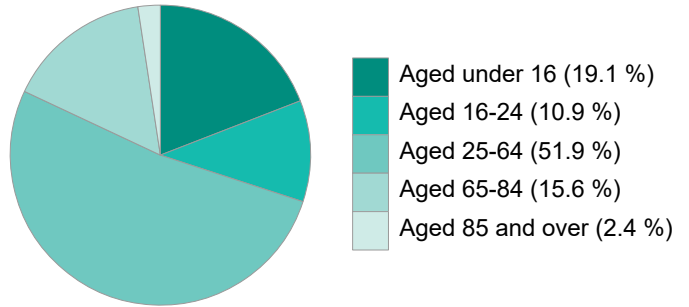

England



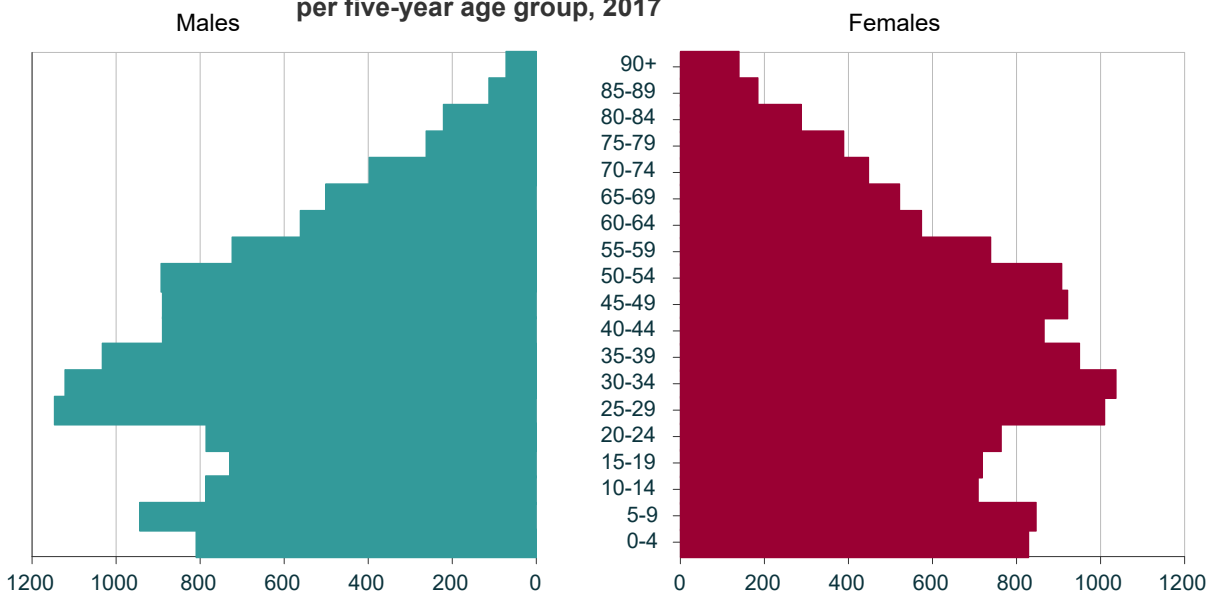

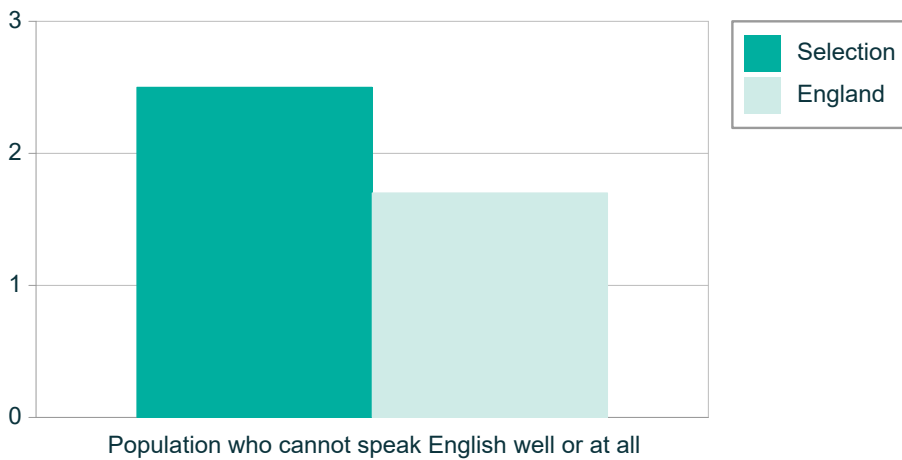

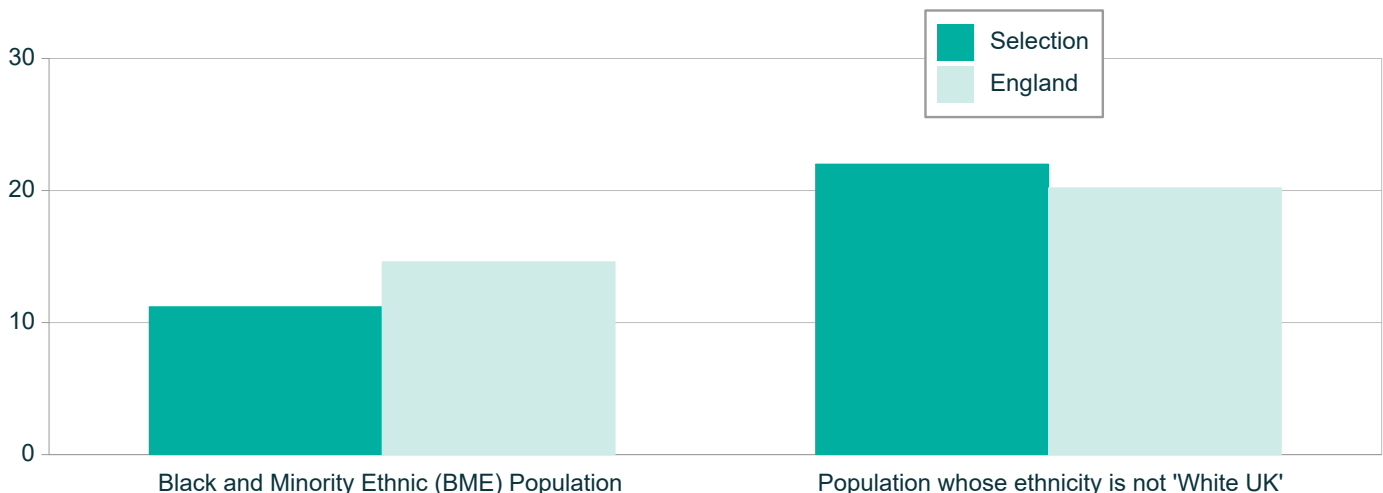

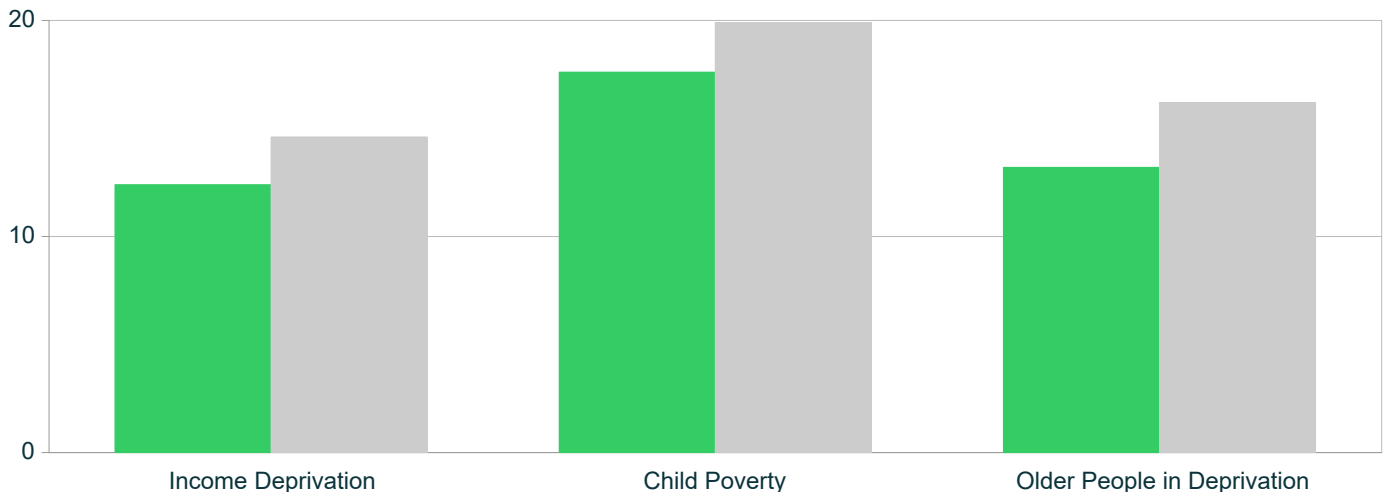

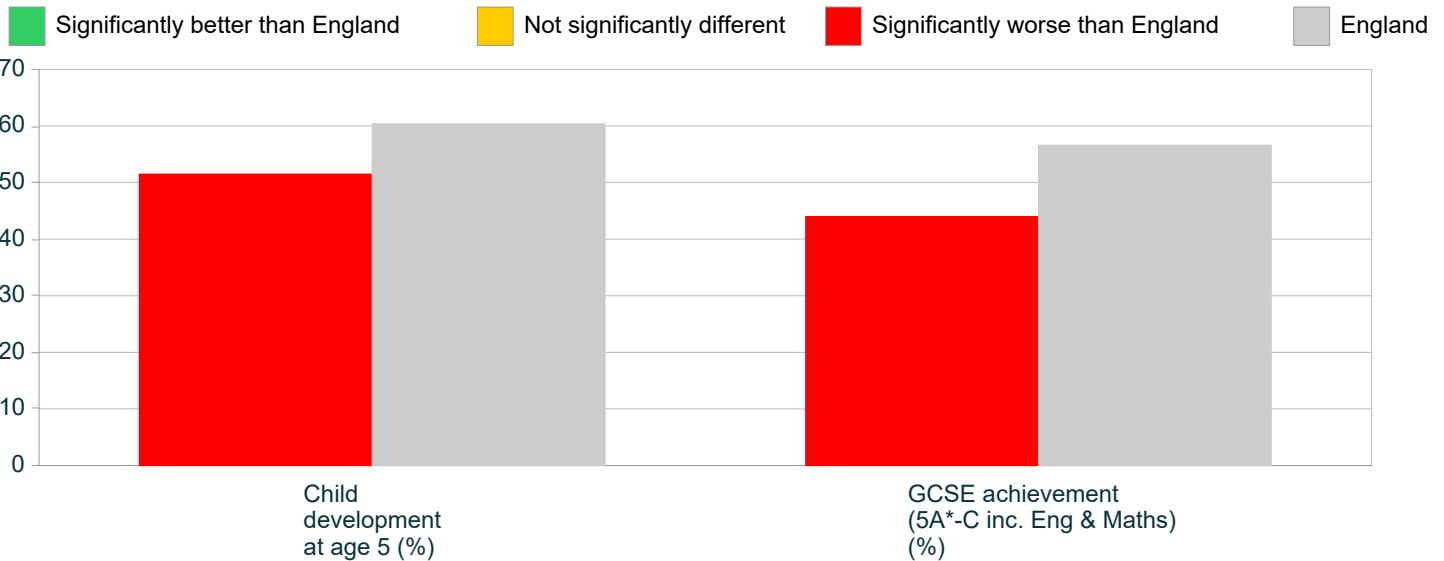

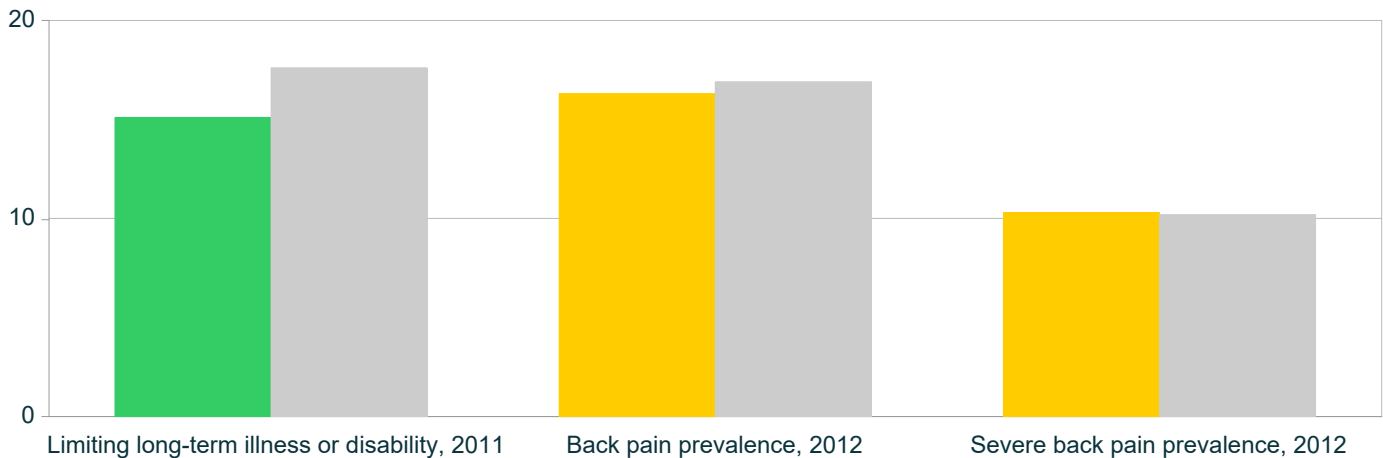

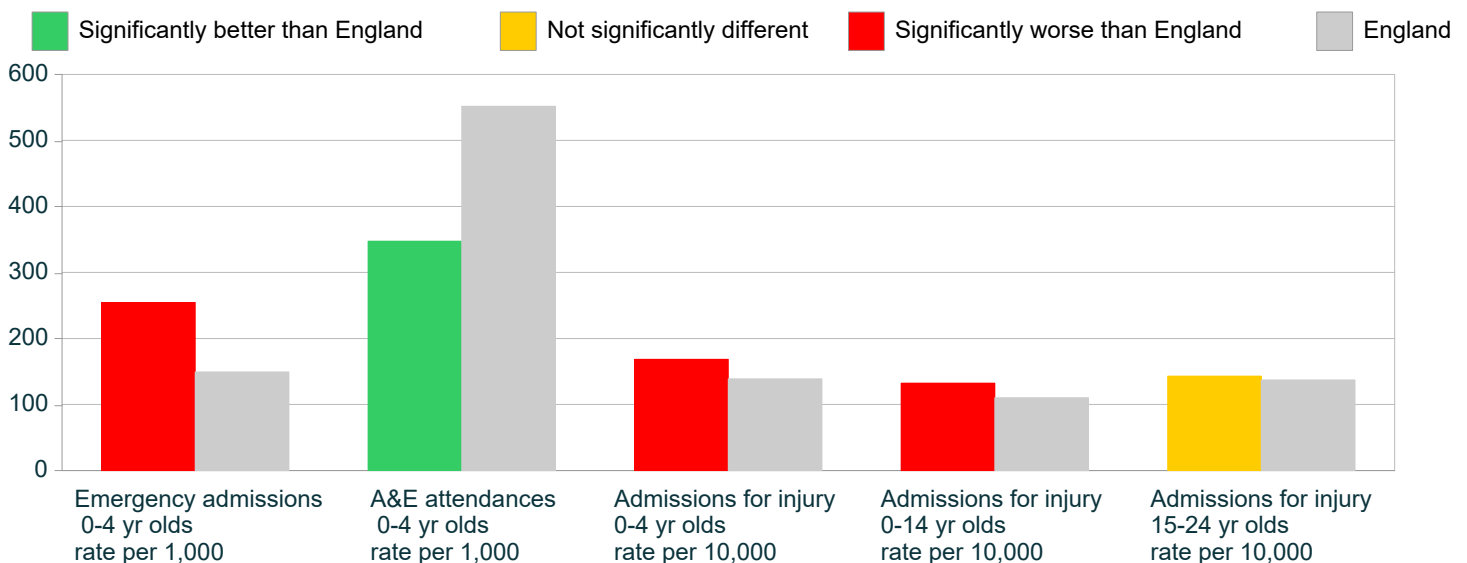

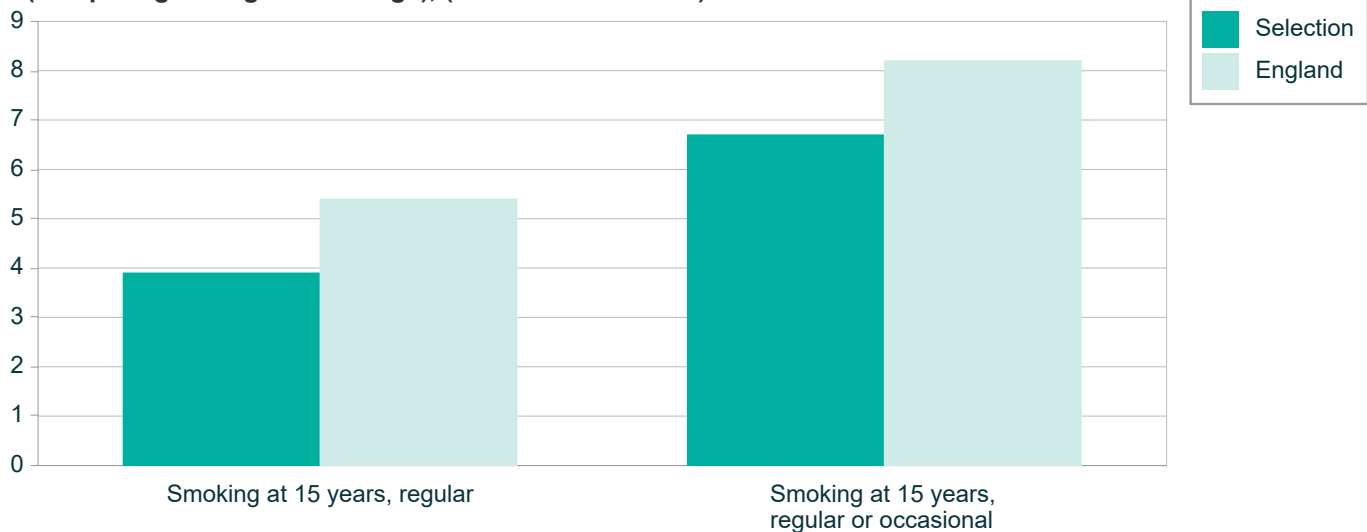

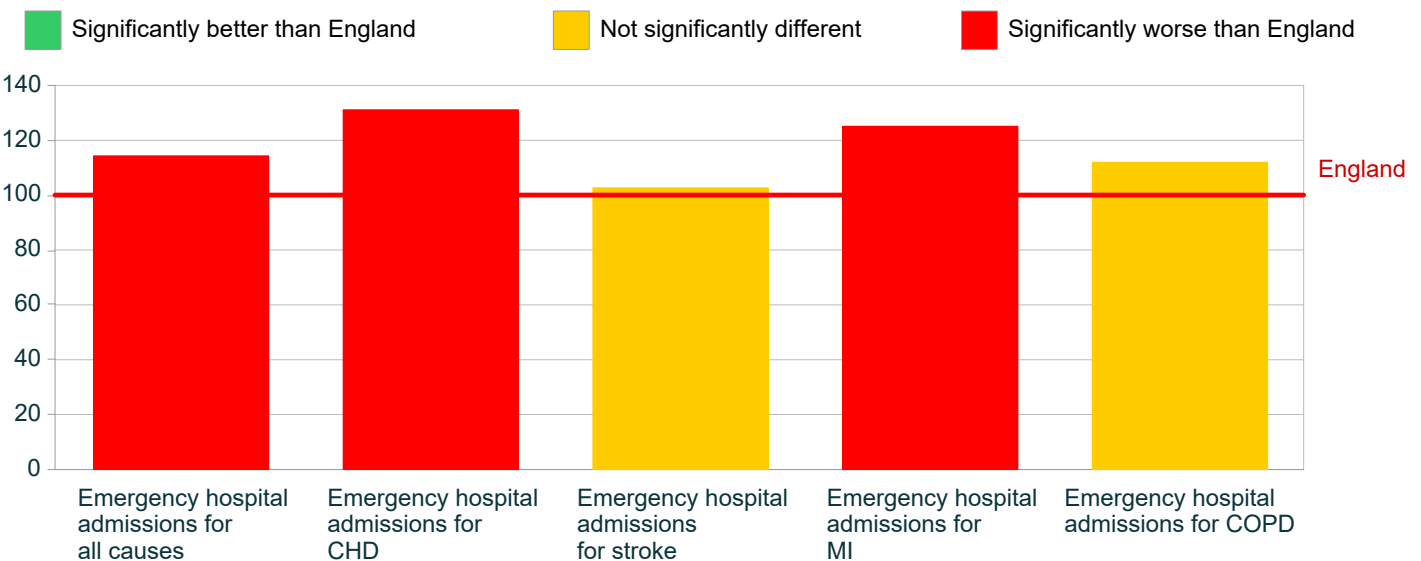

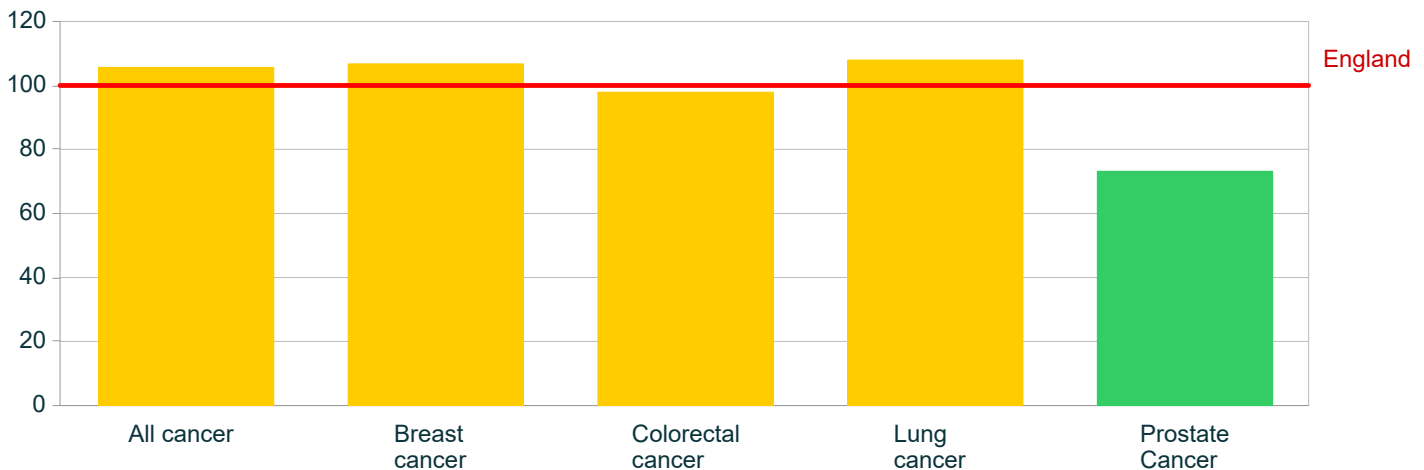

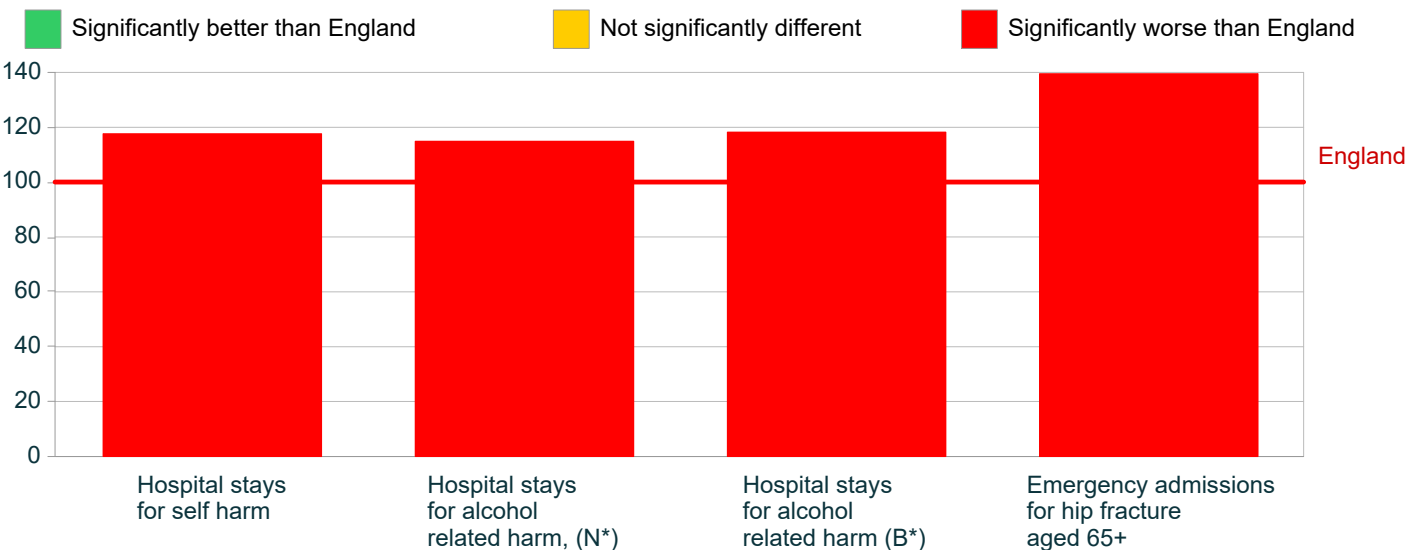

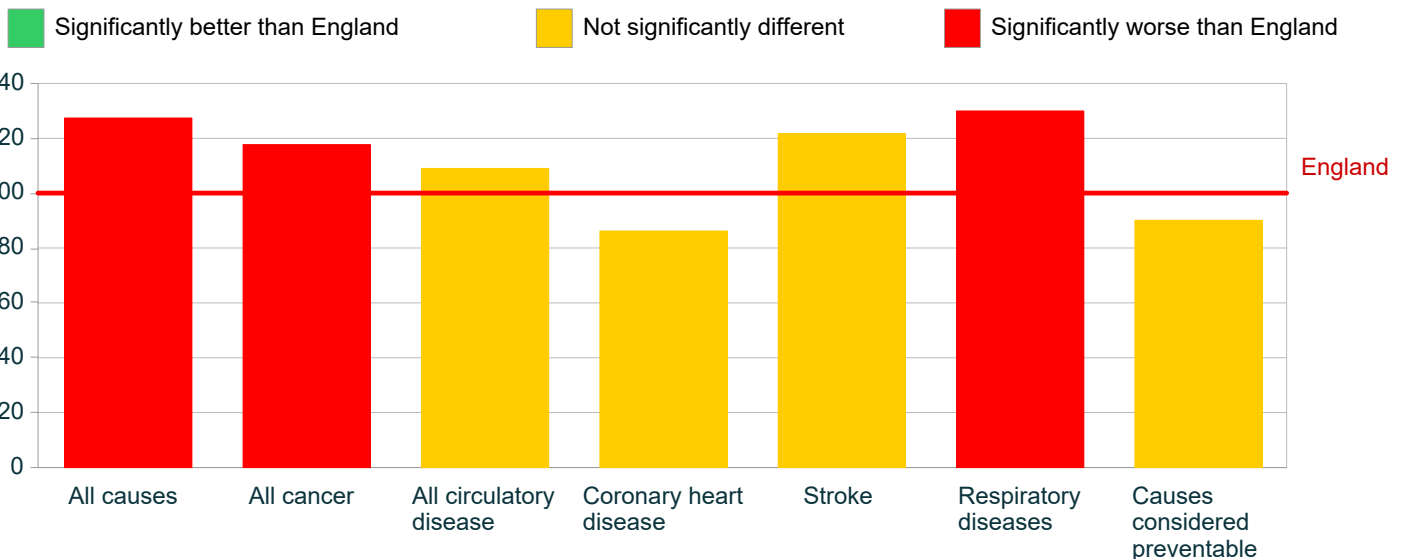

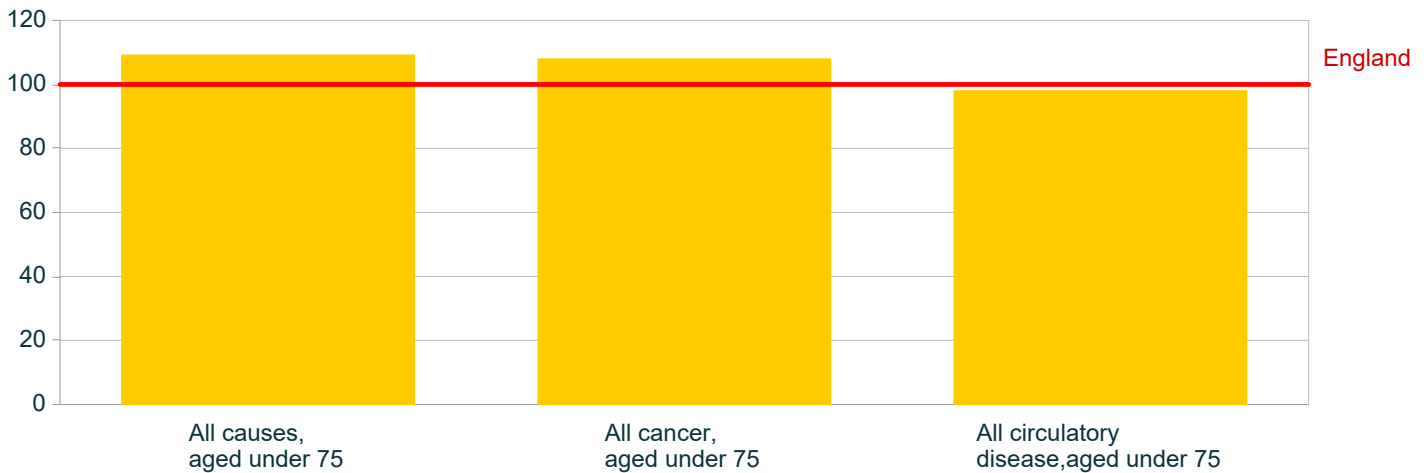
