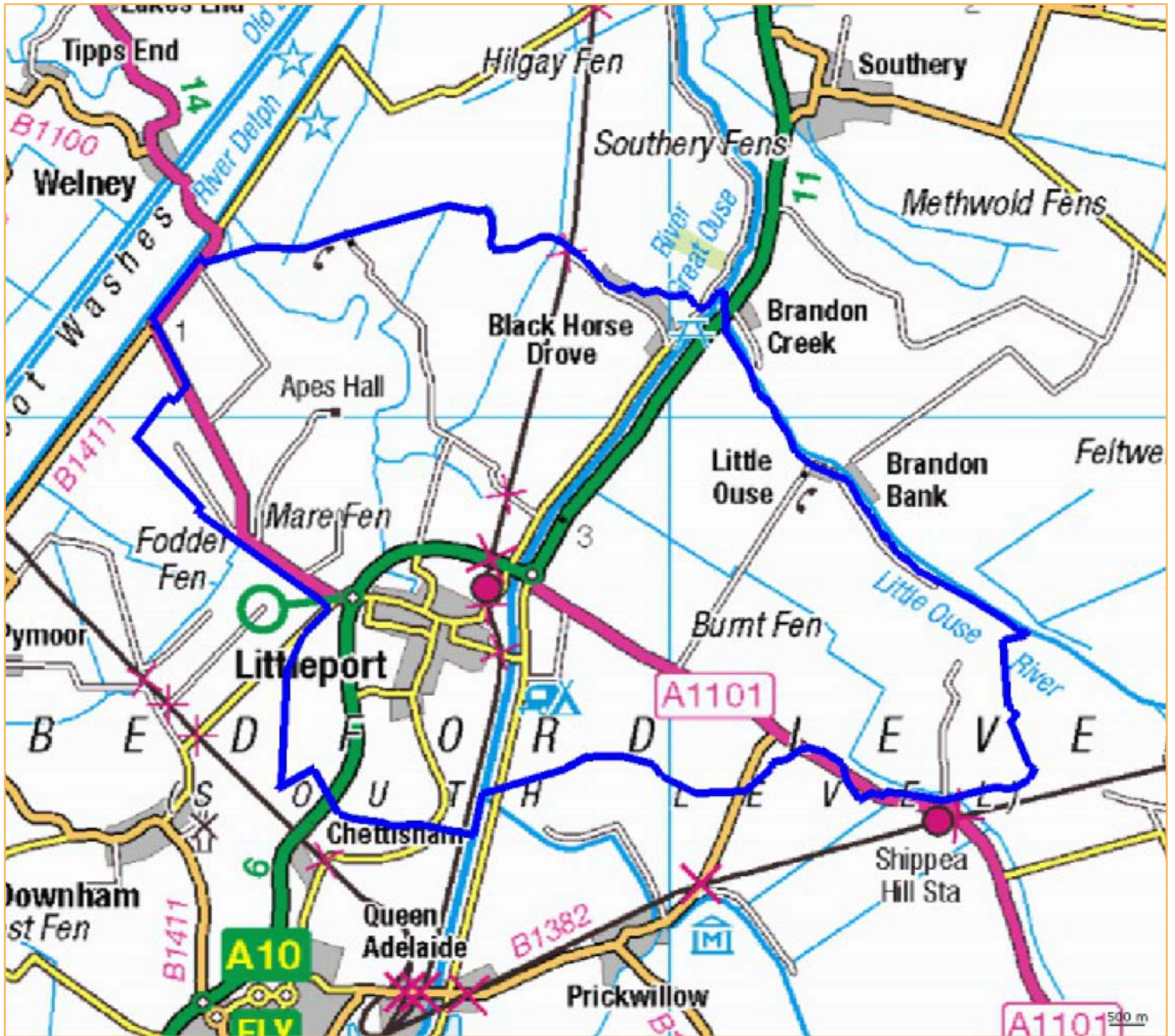

Presentation map



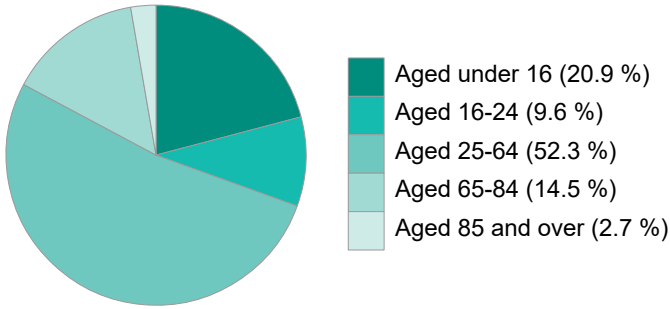

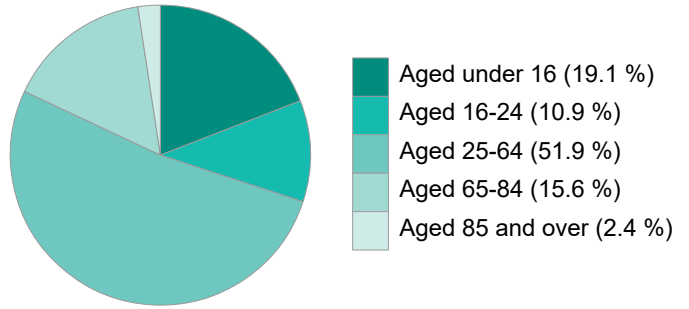

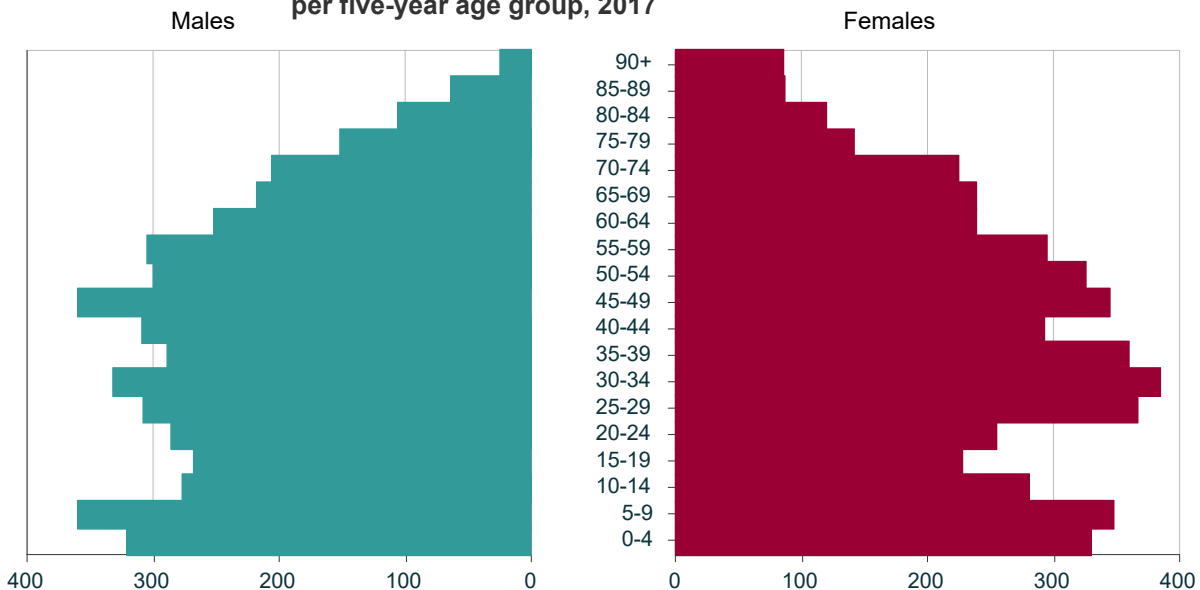

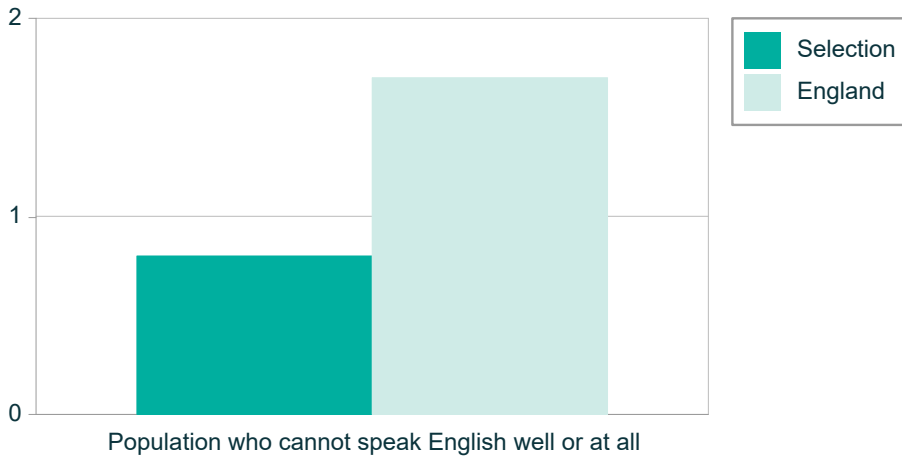

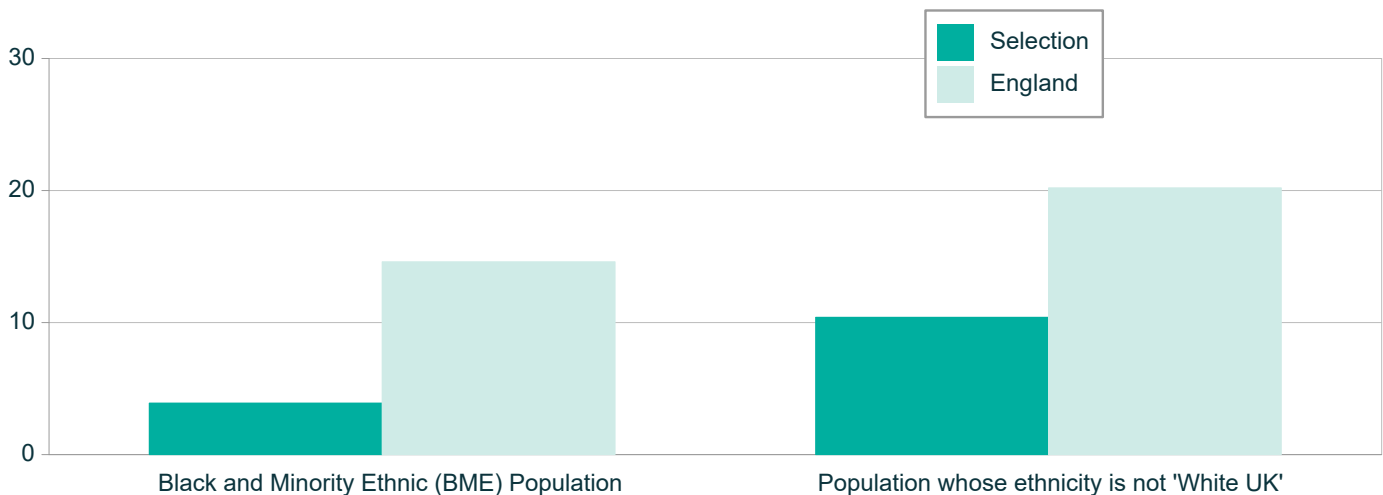

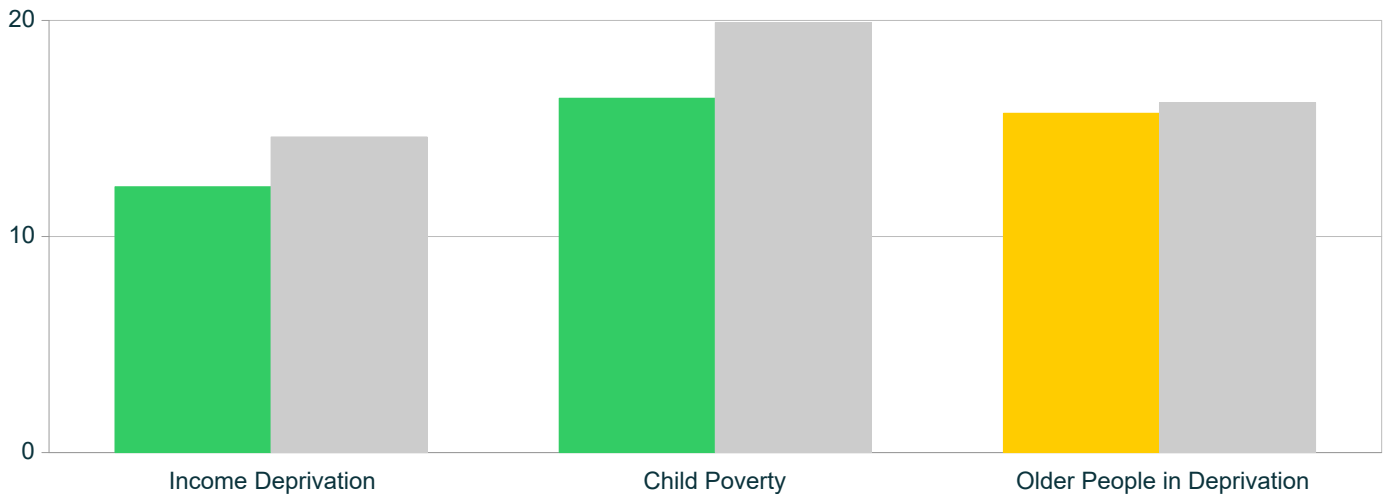

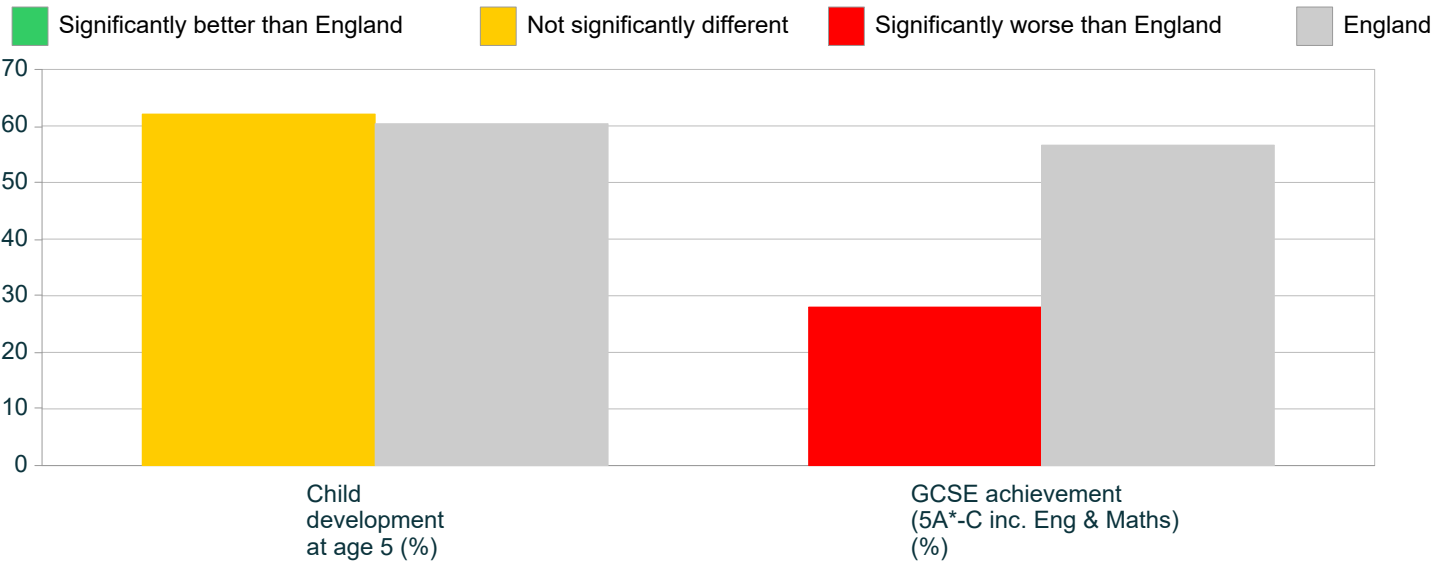

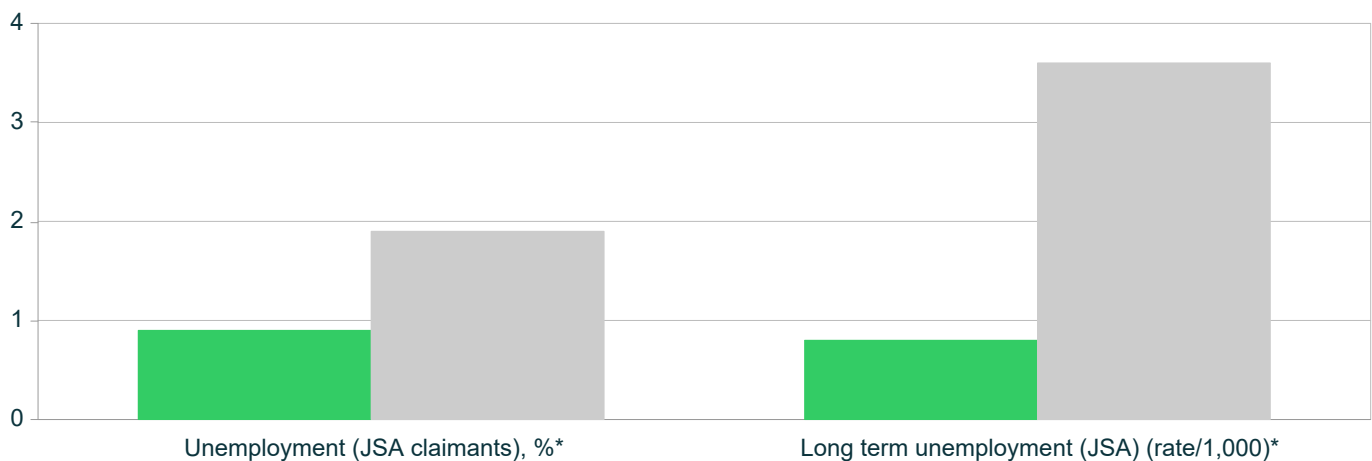

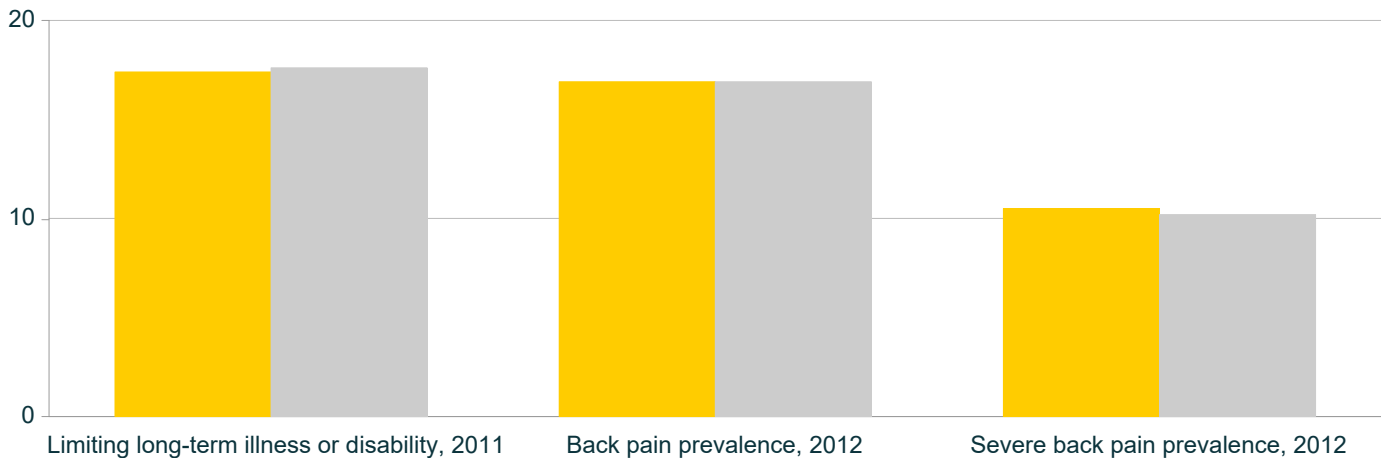

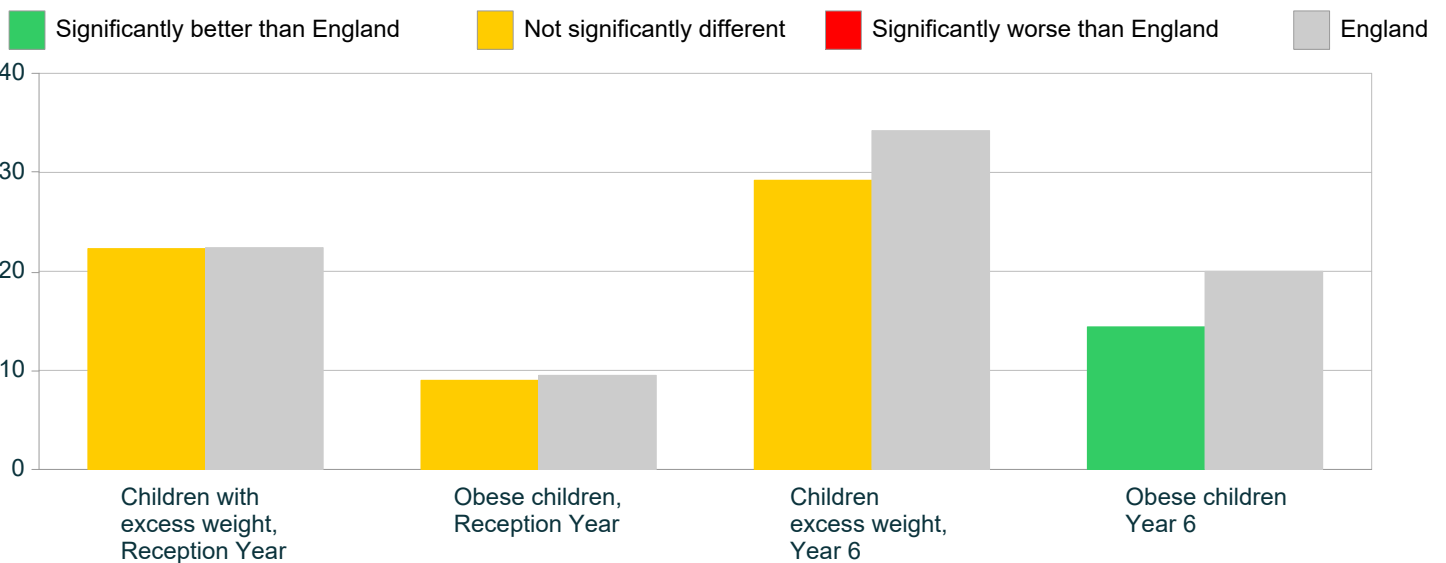

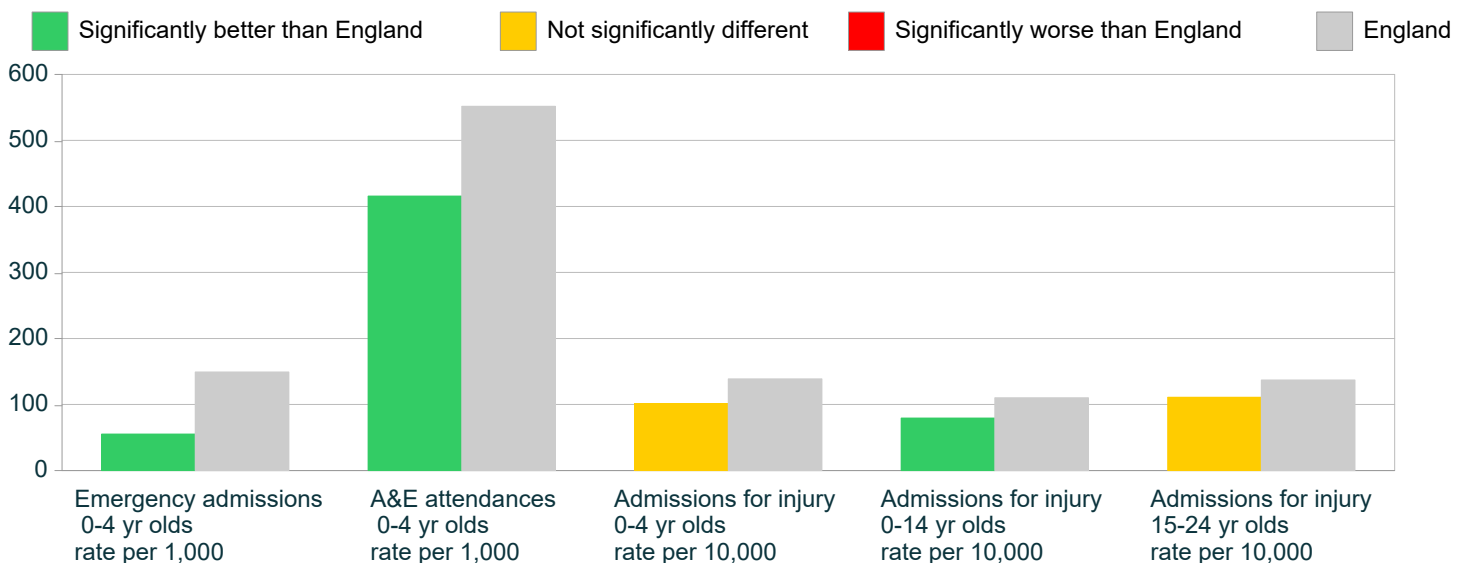

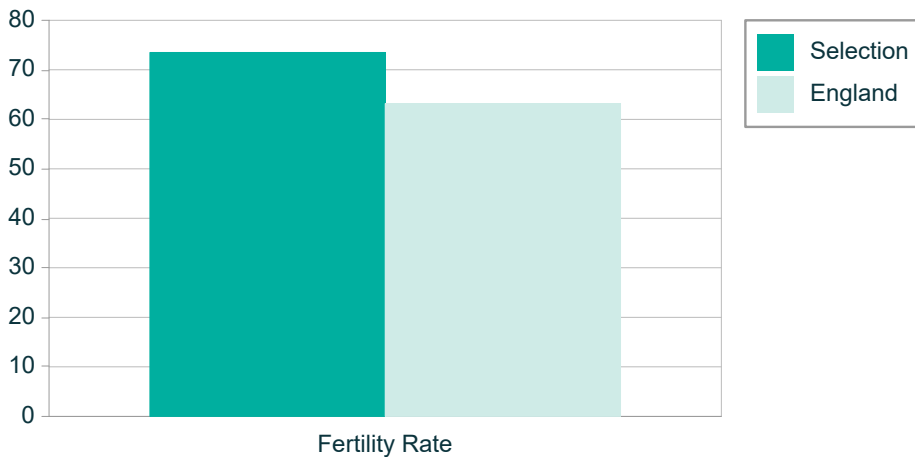

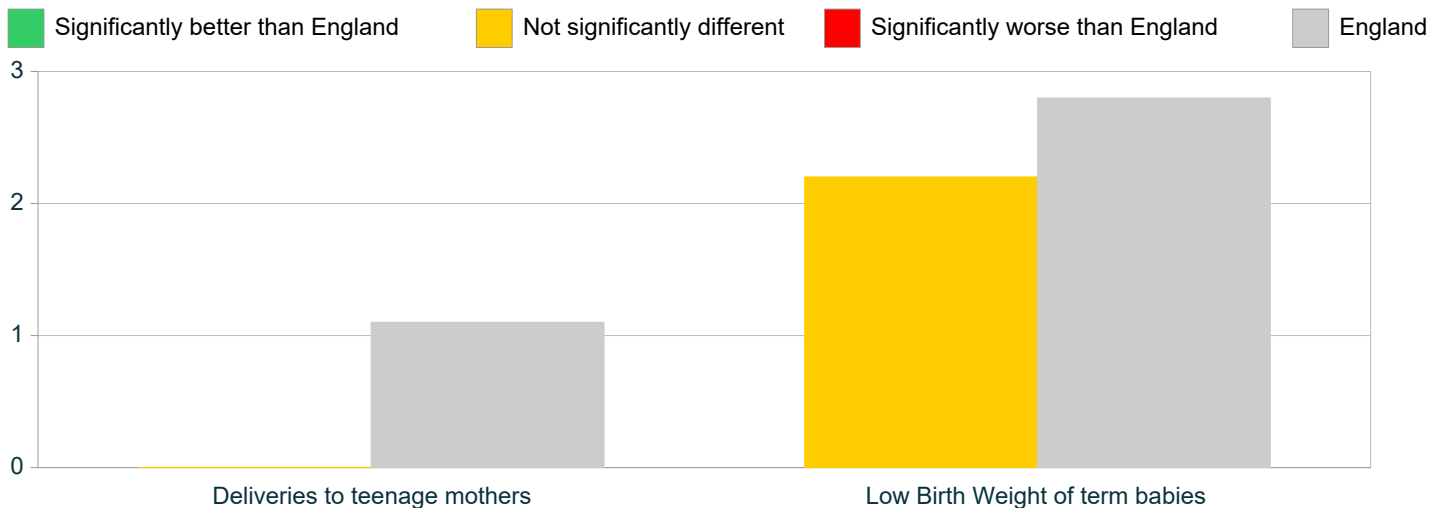

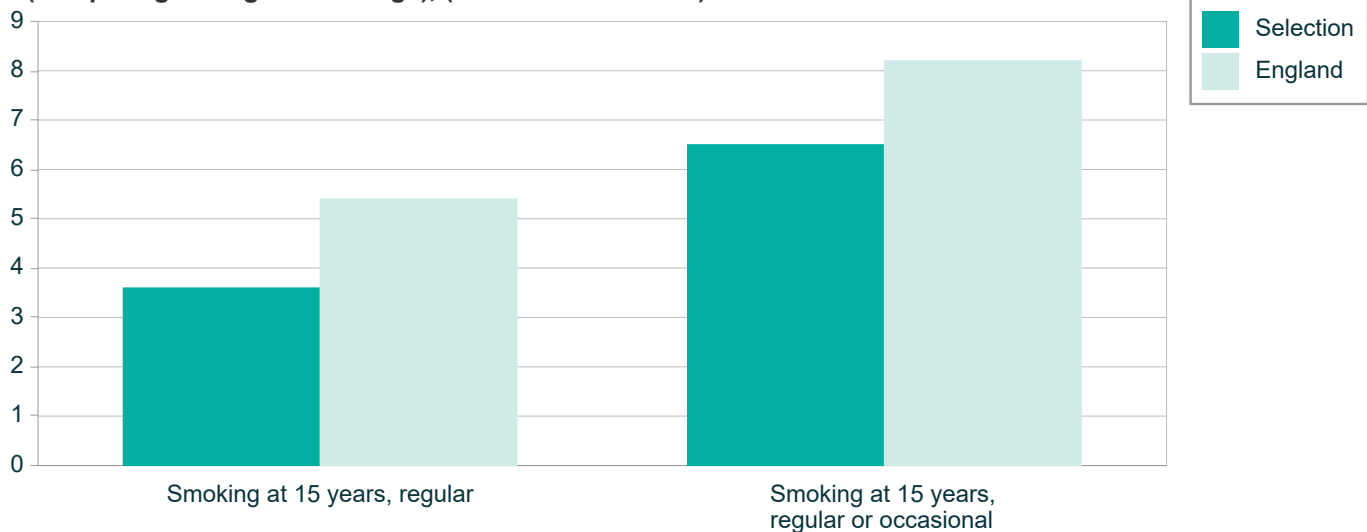

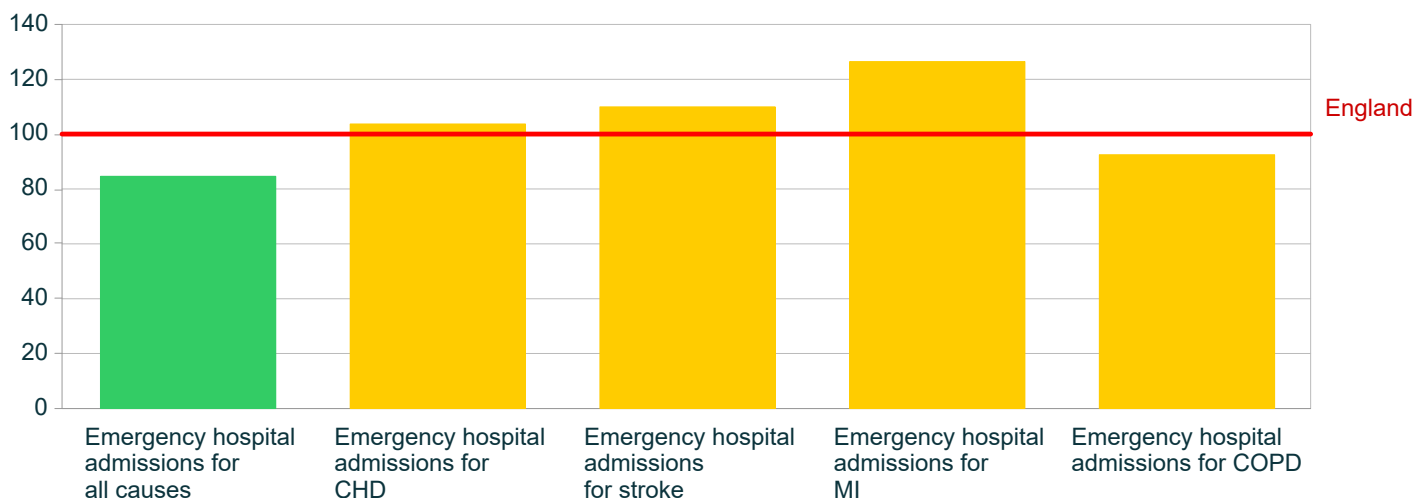

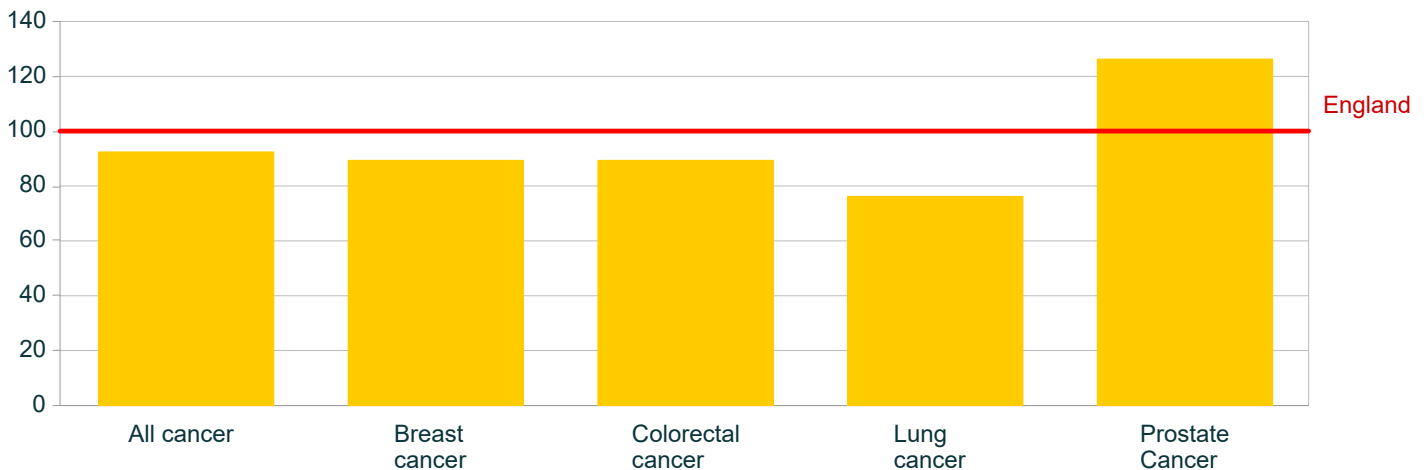

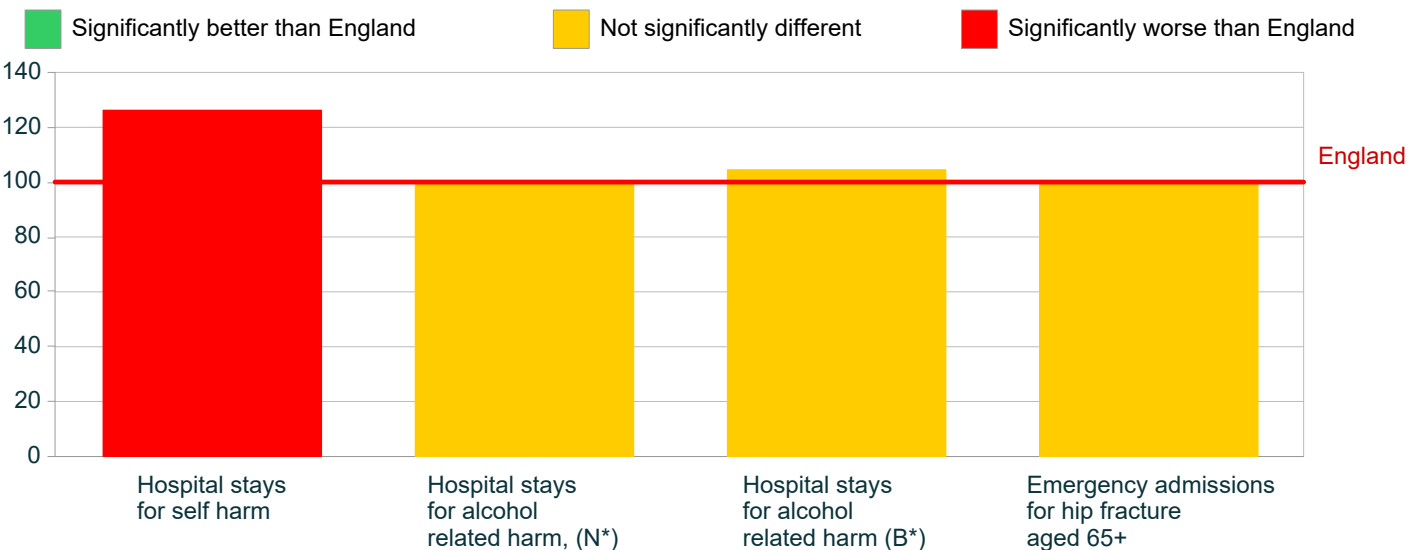

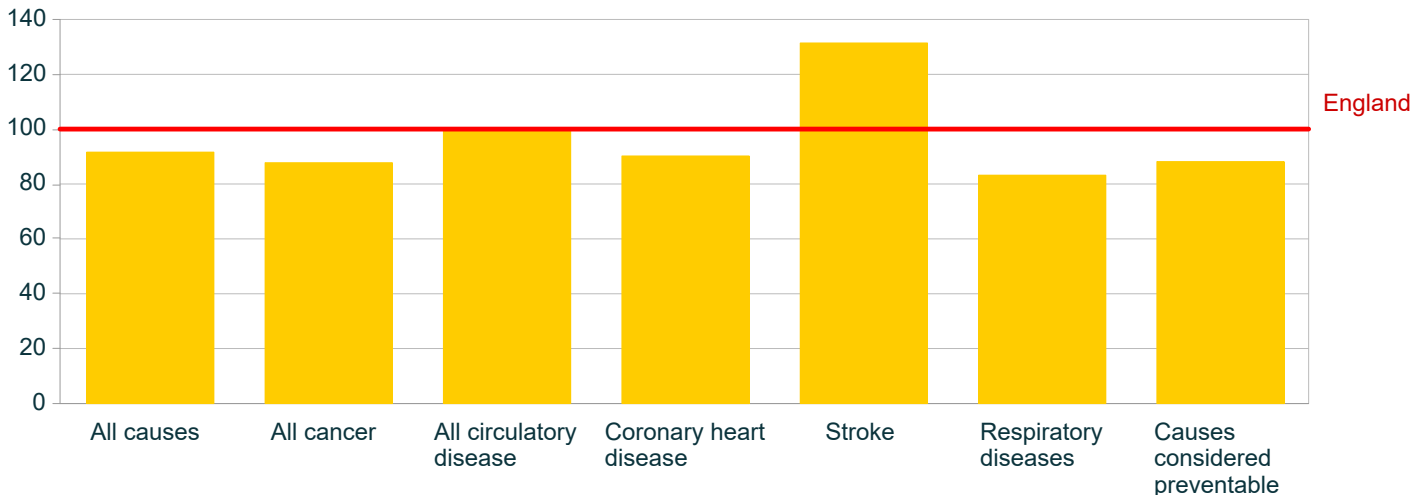

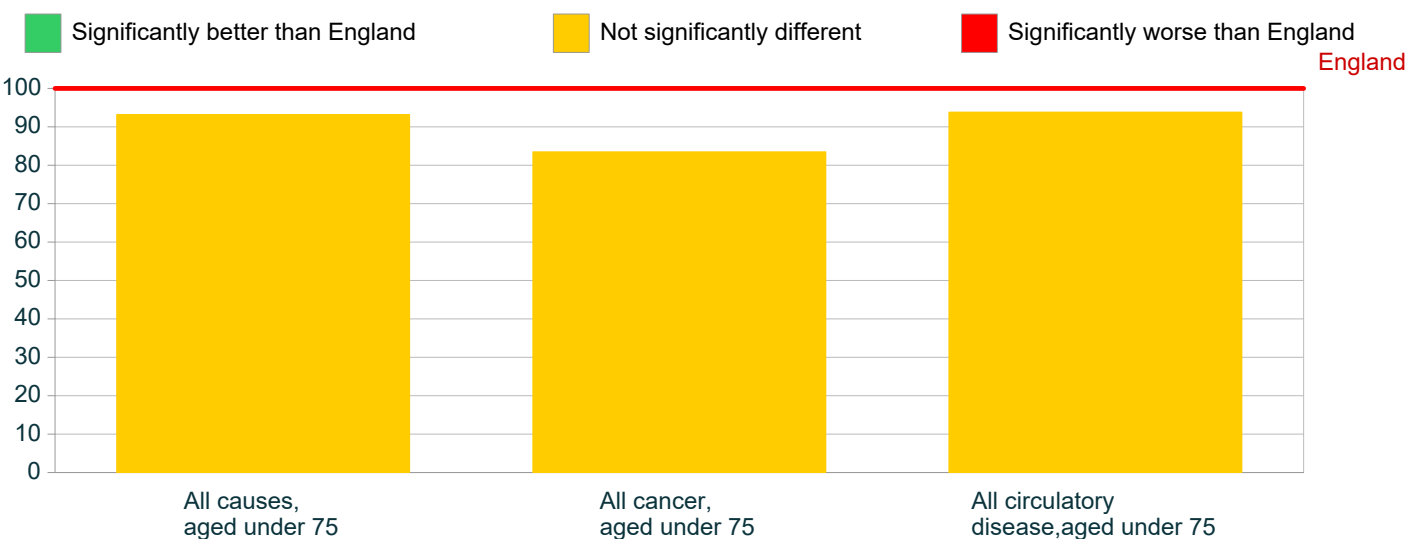

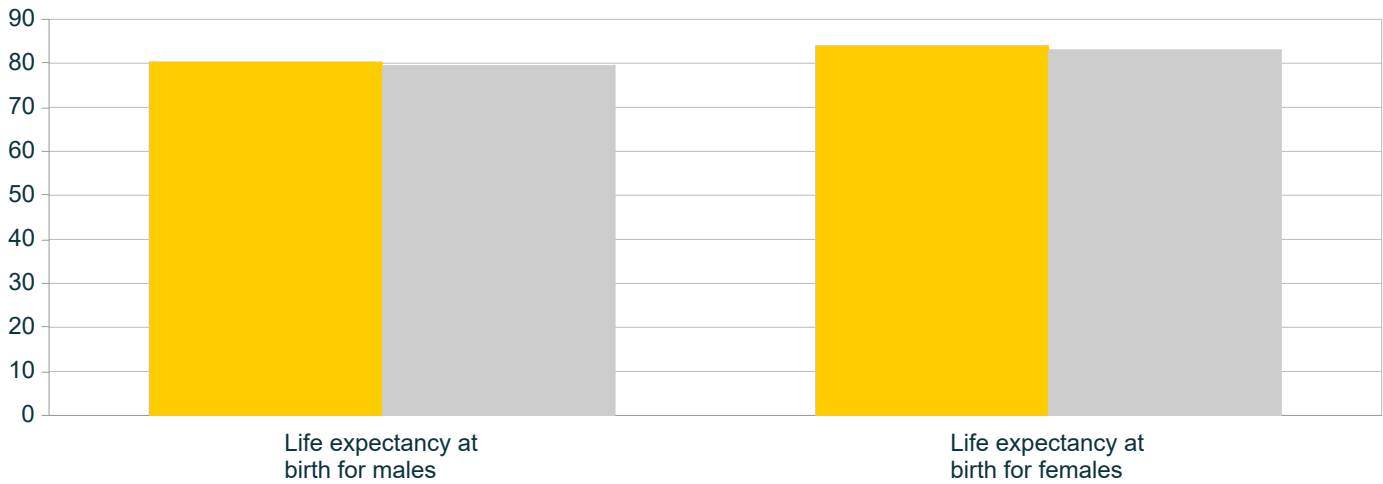

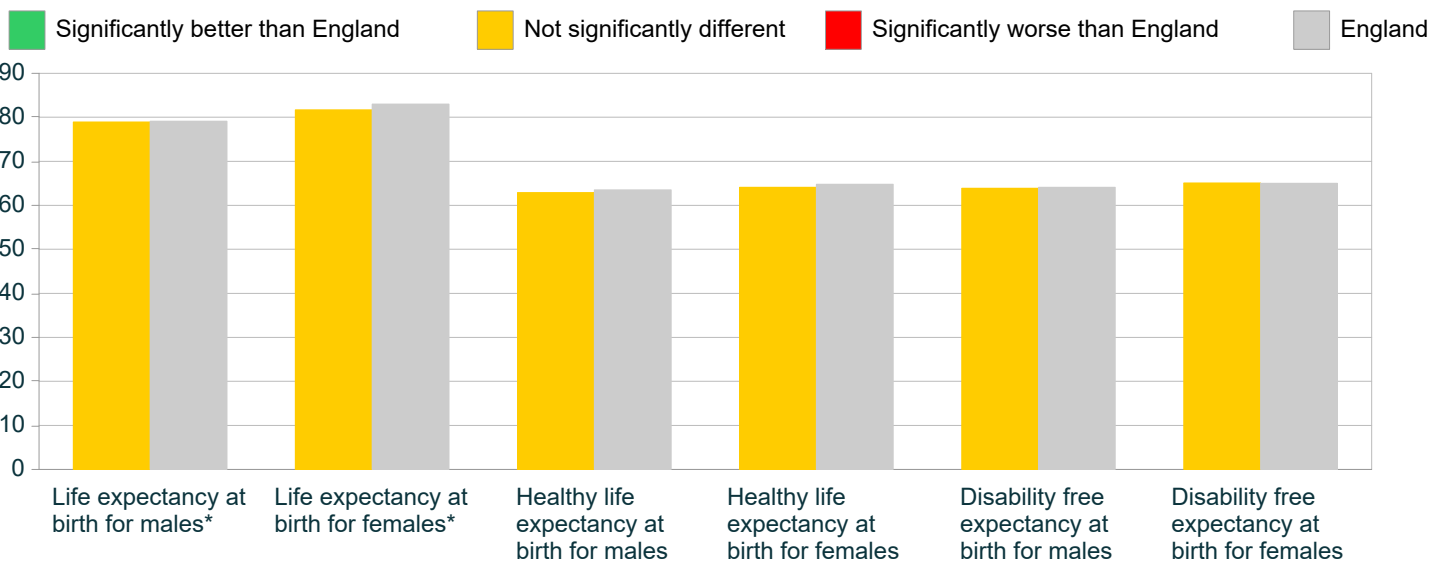
