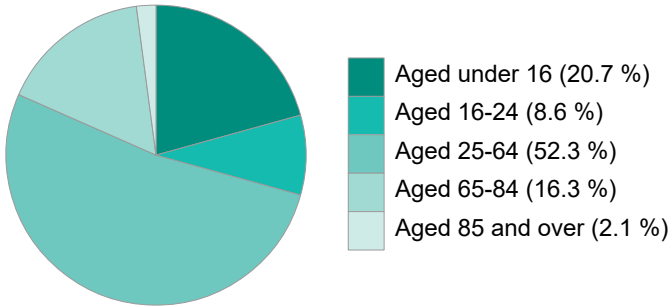

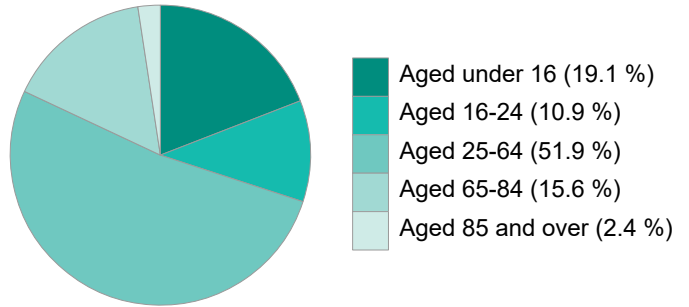

England



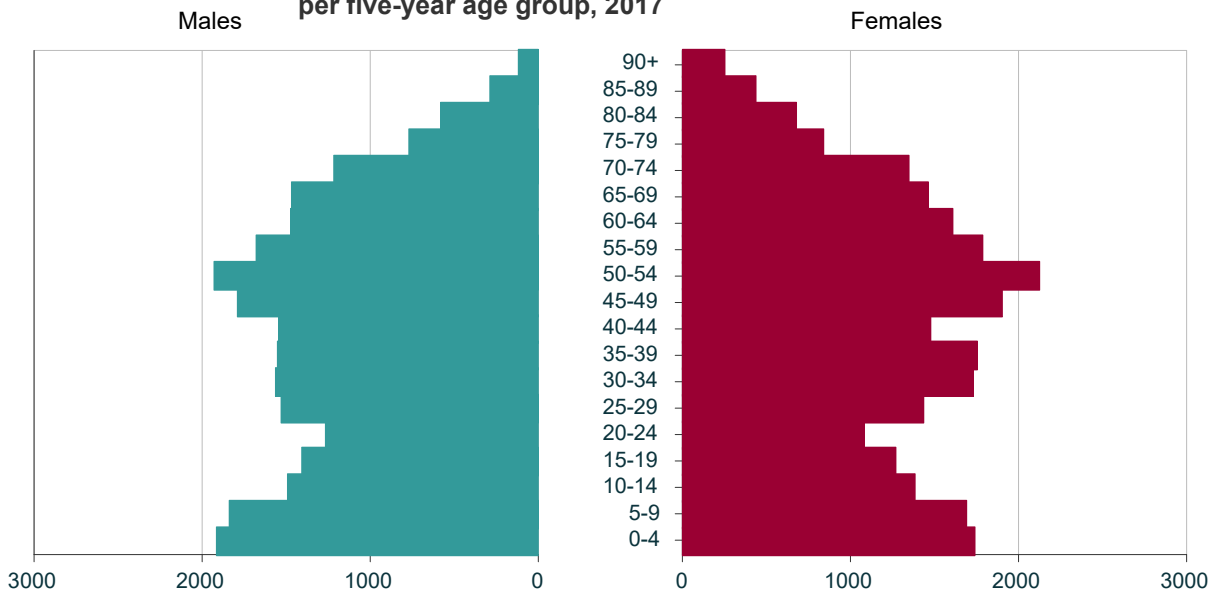

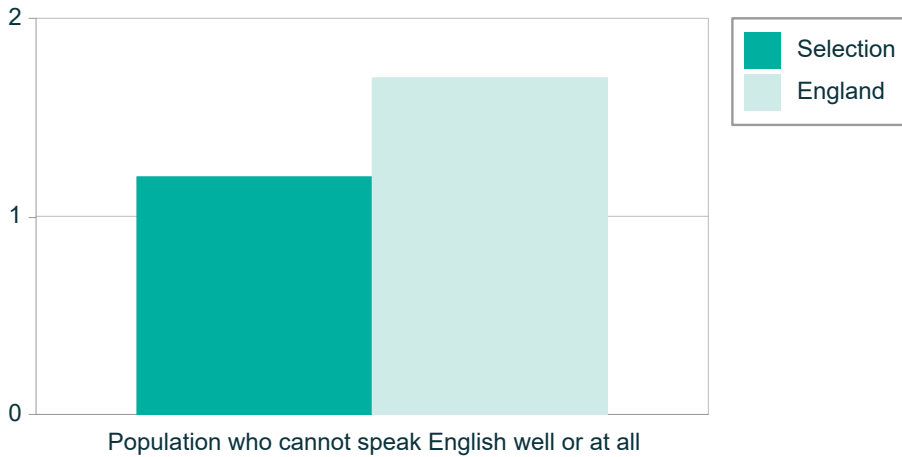

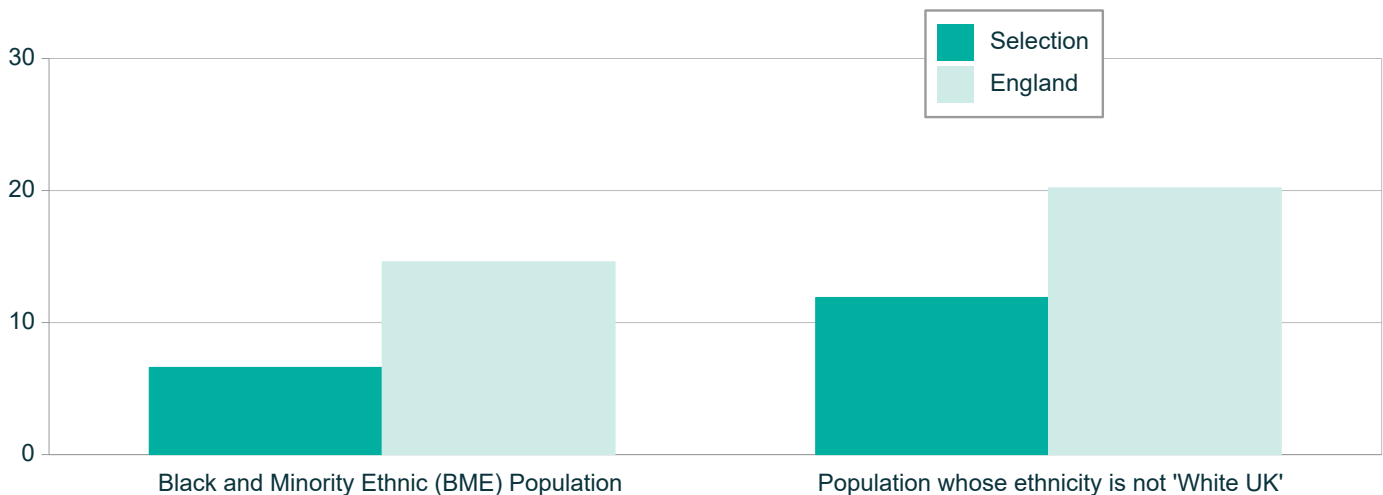

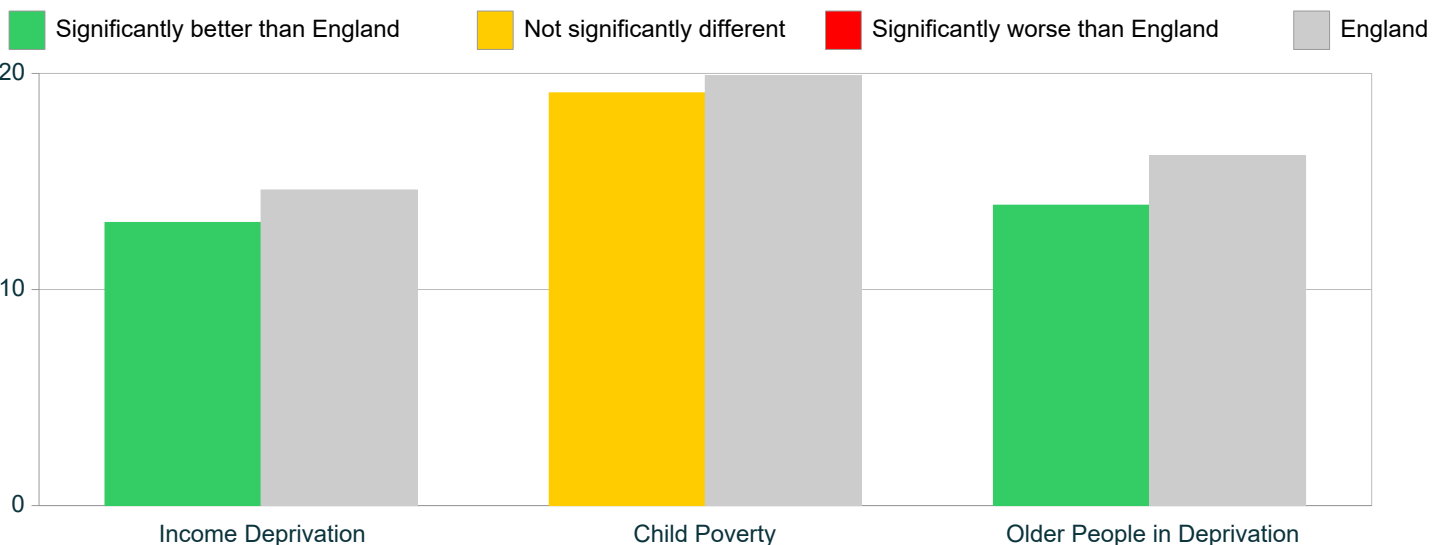

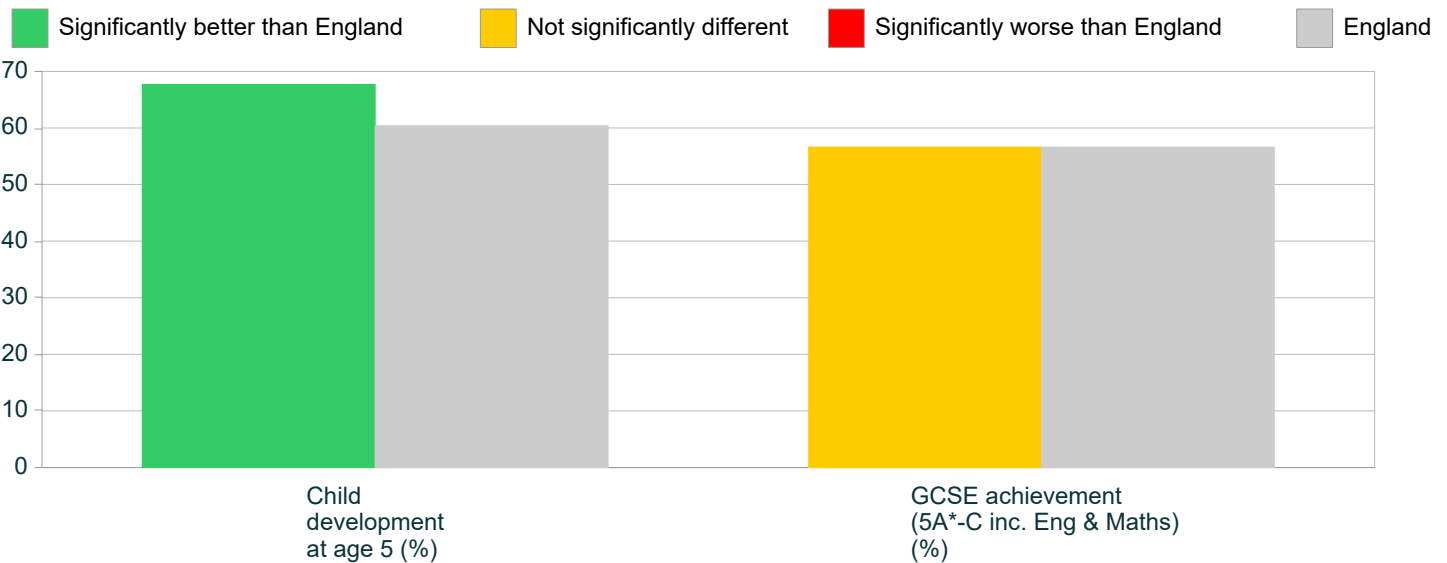

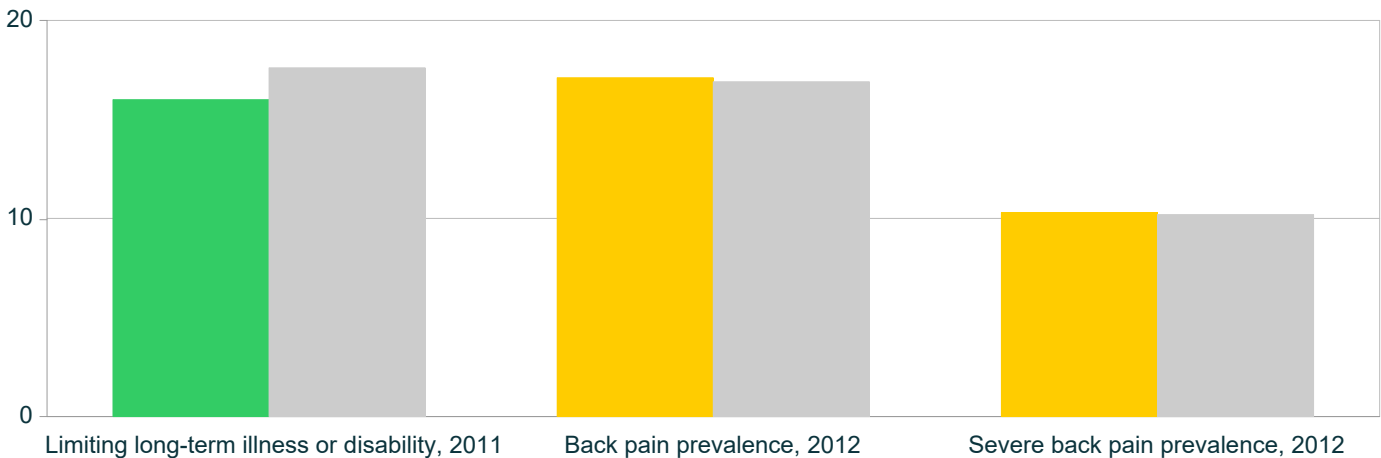

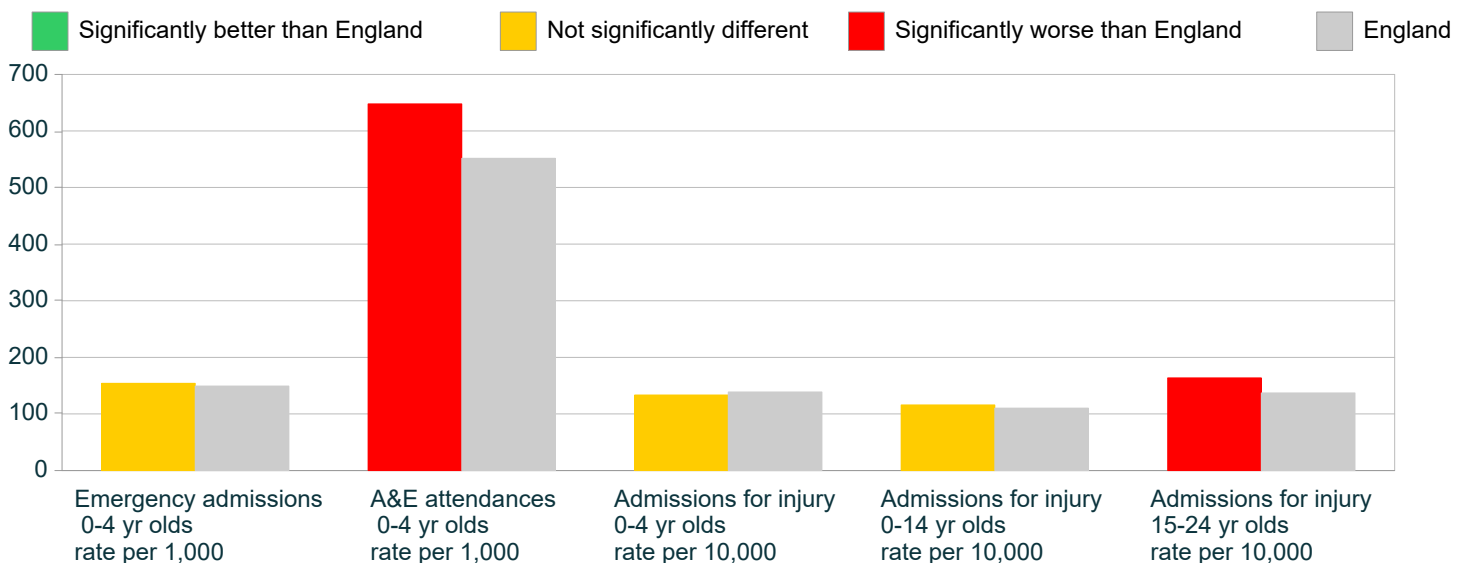

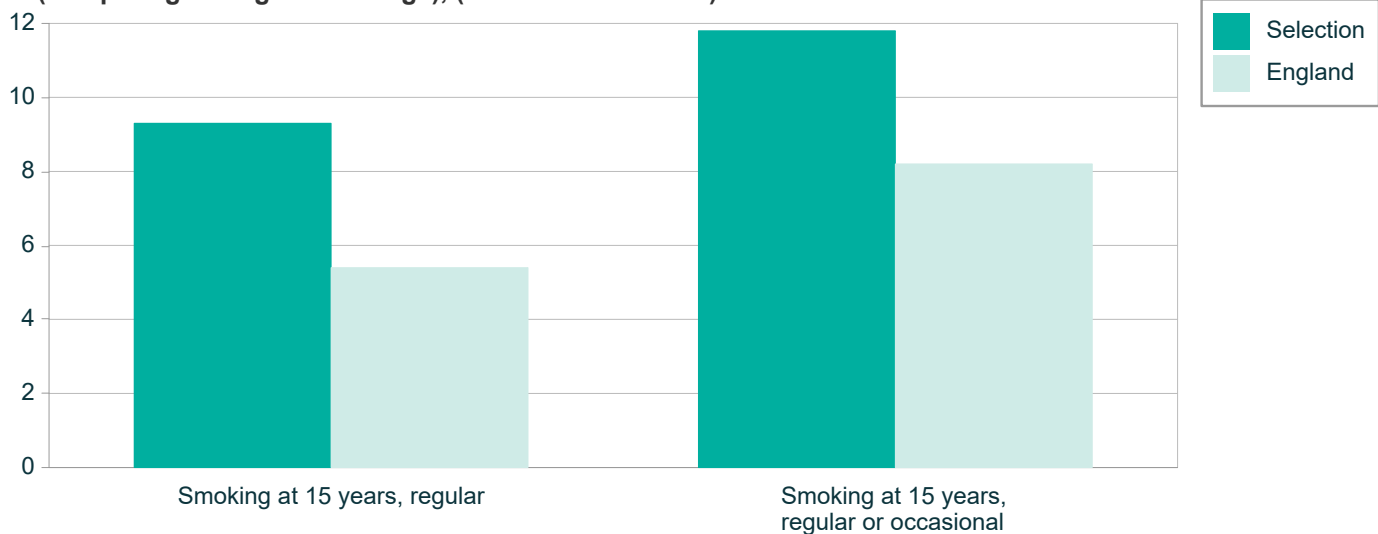

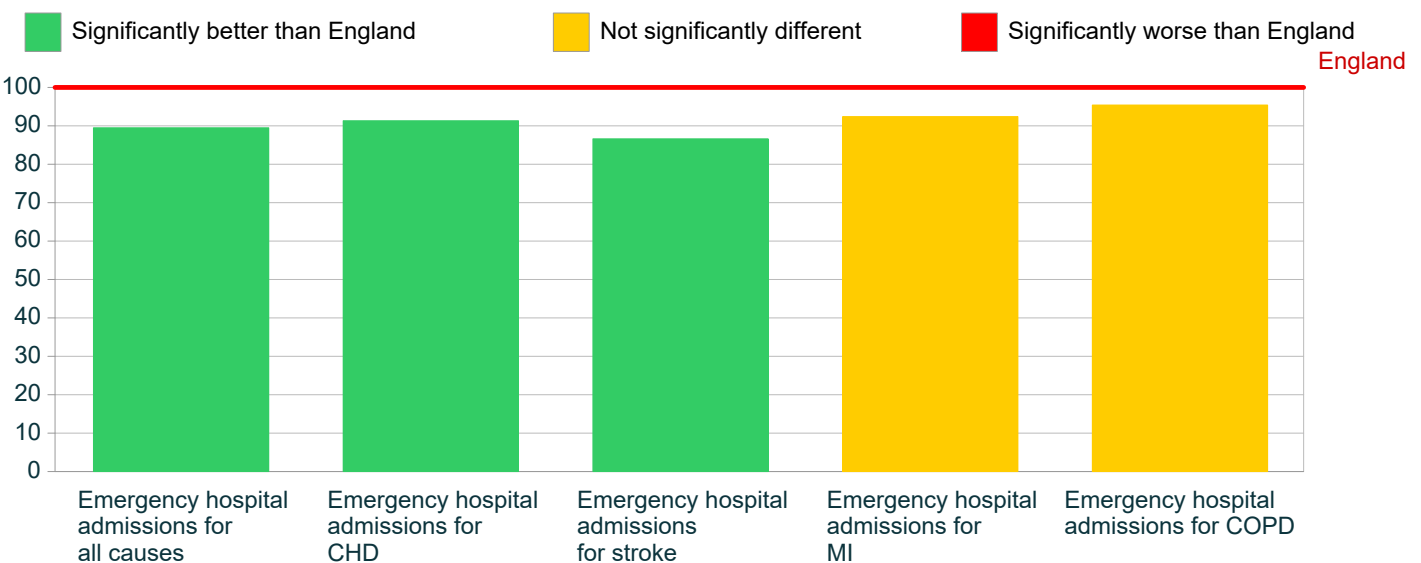

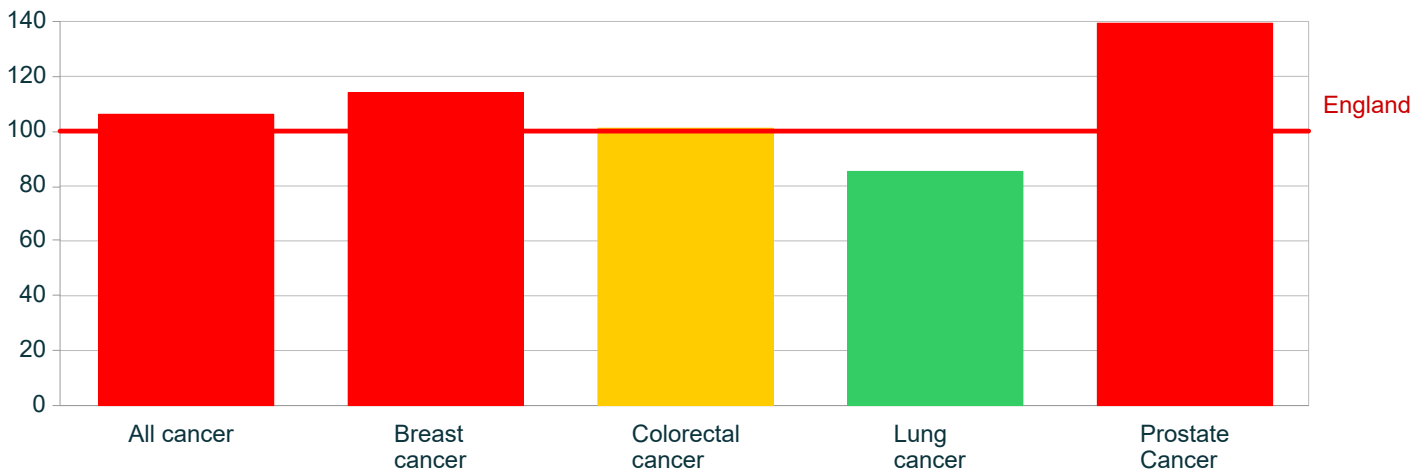

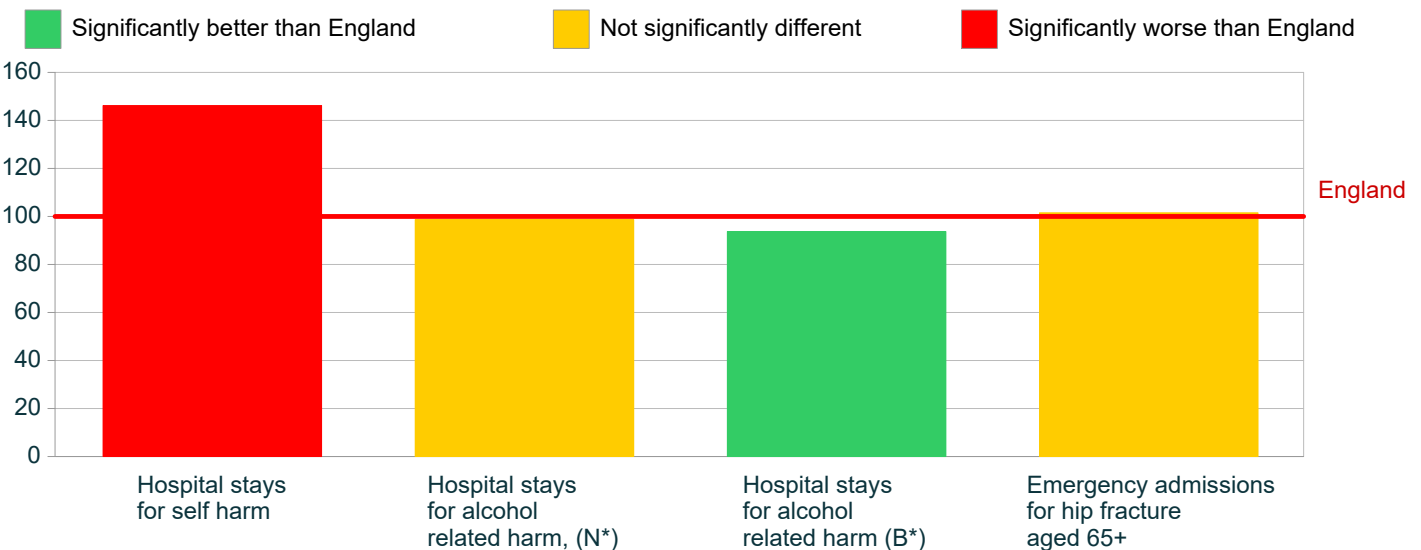

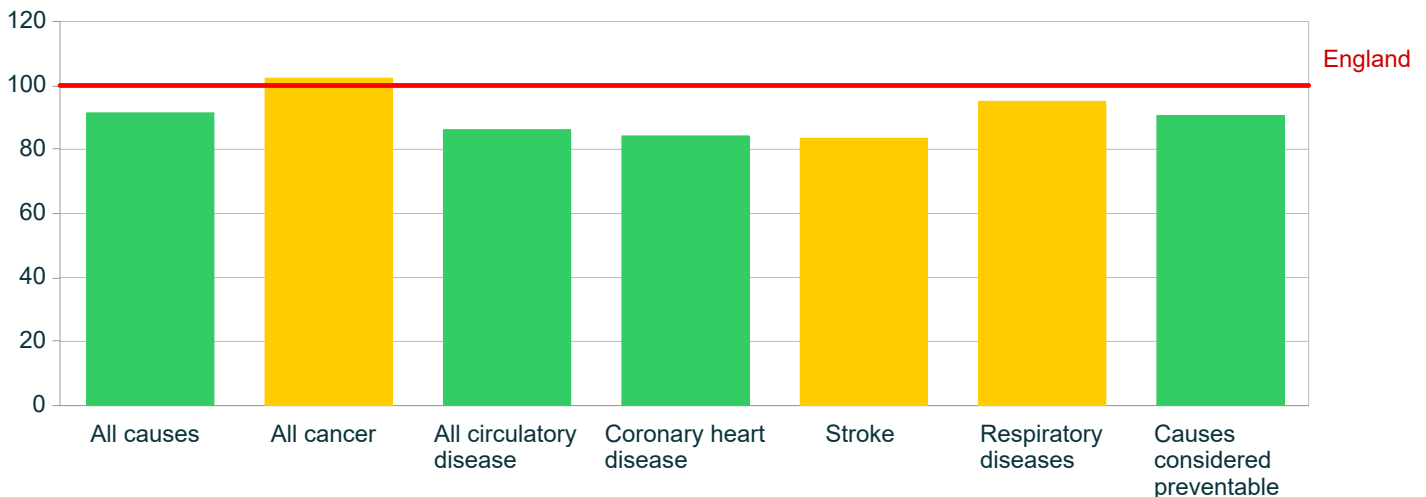

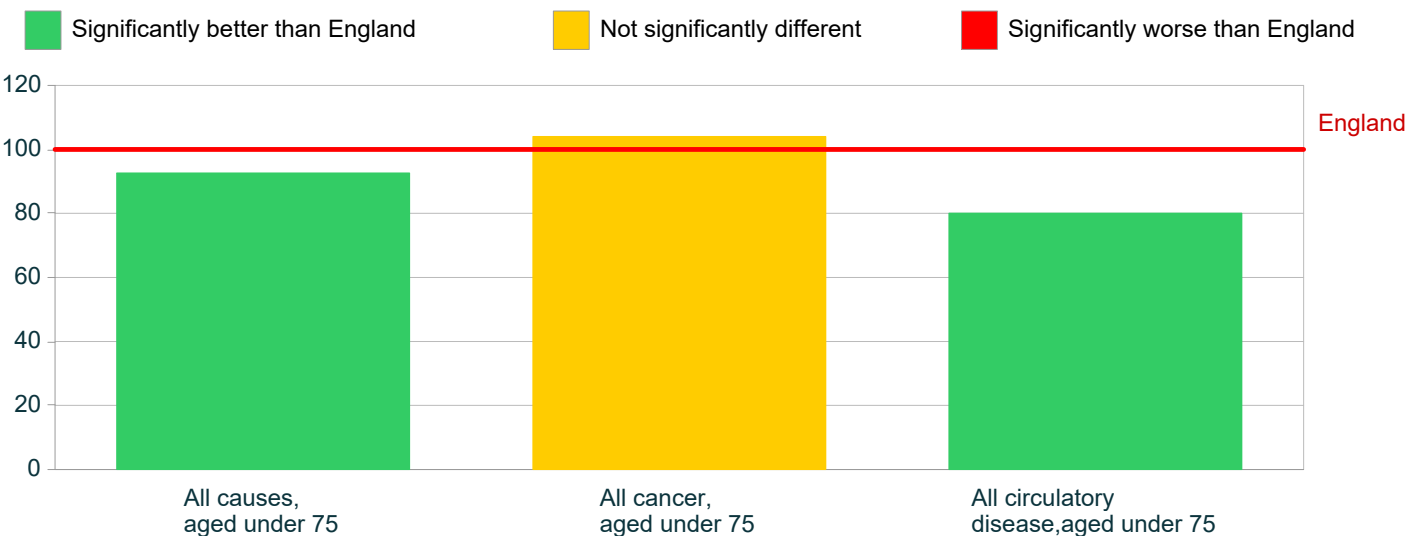
