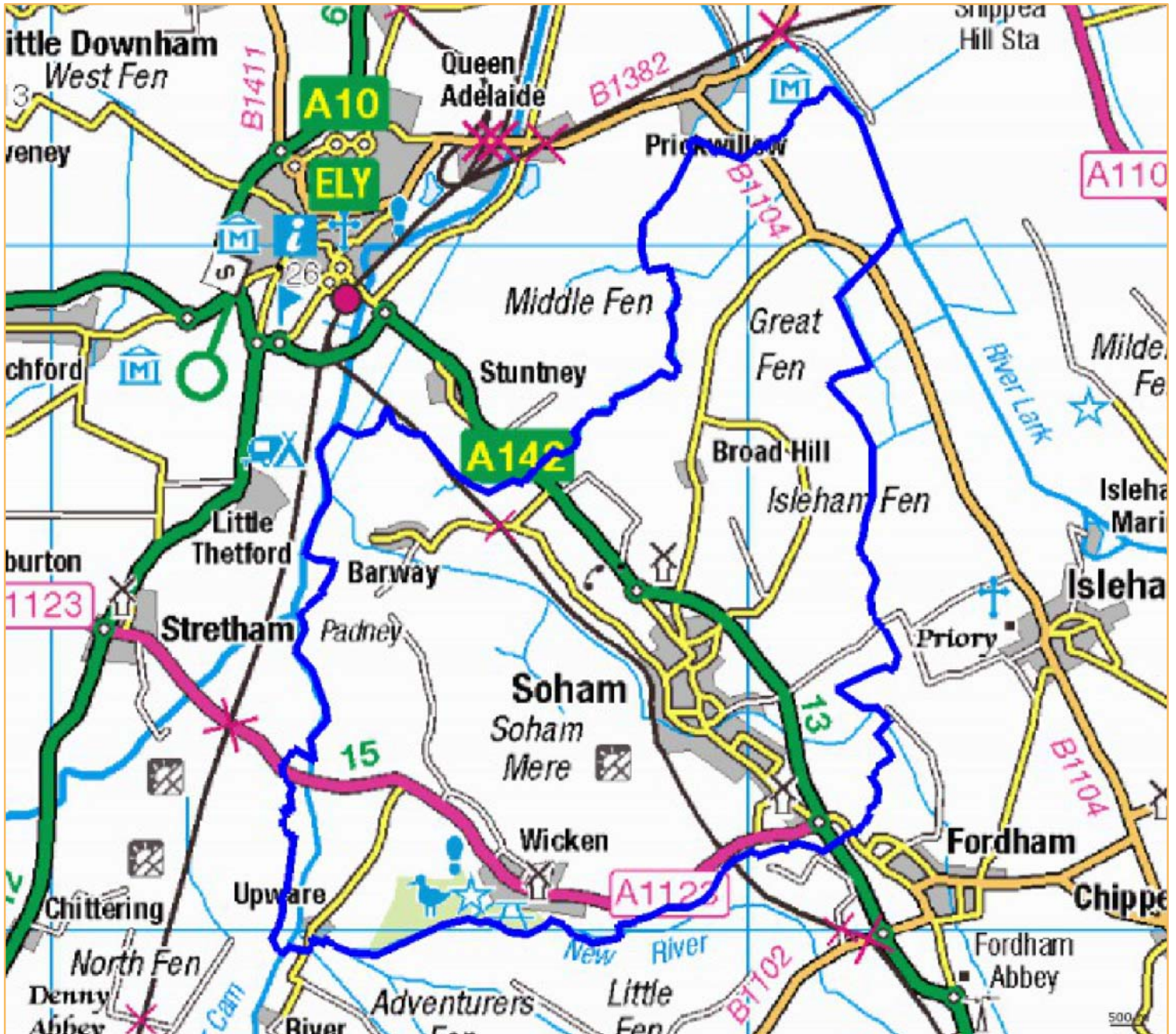

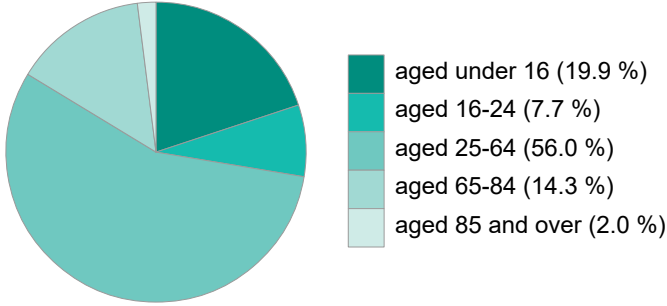

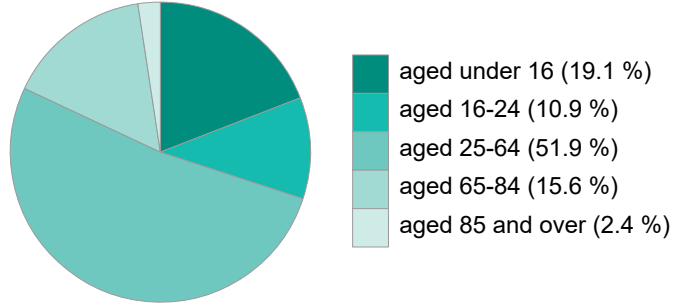

England



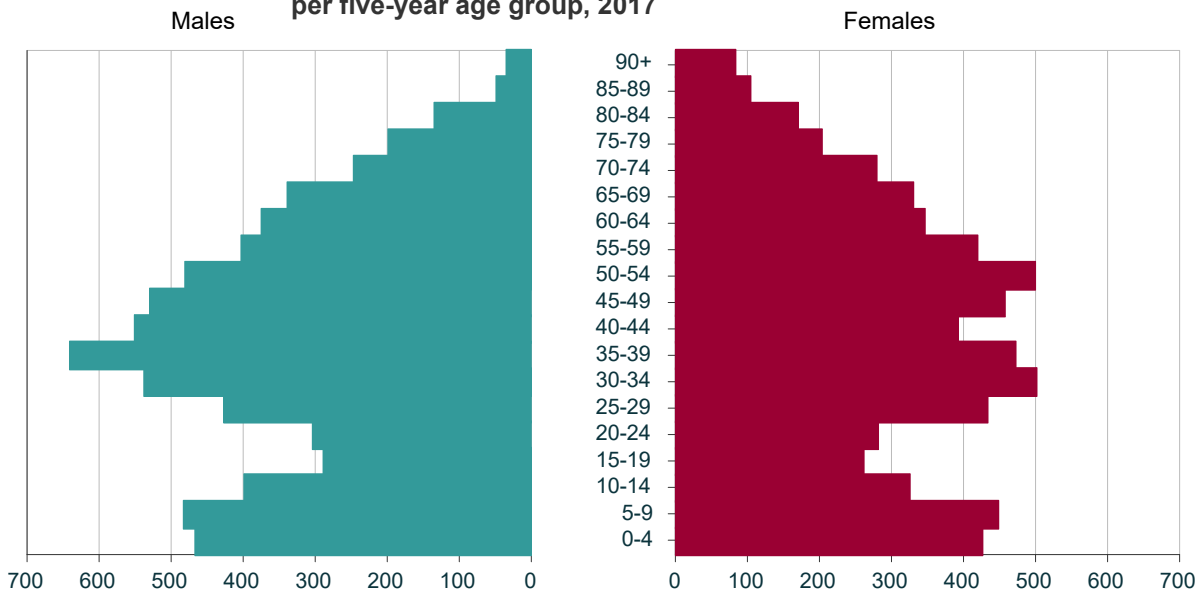

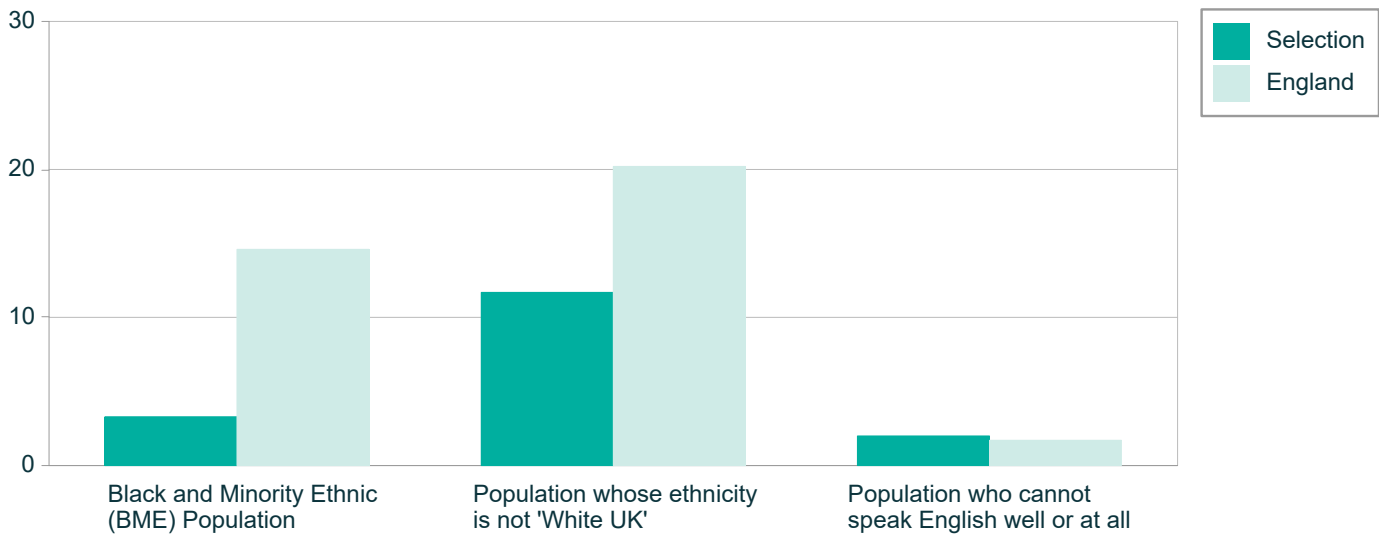

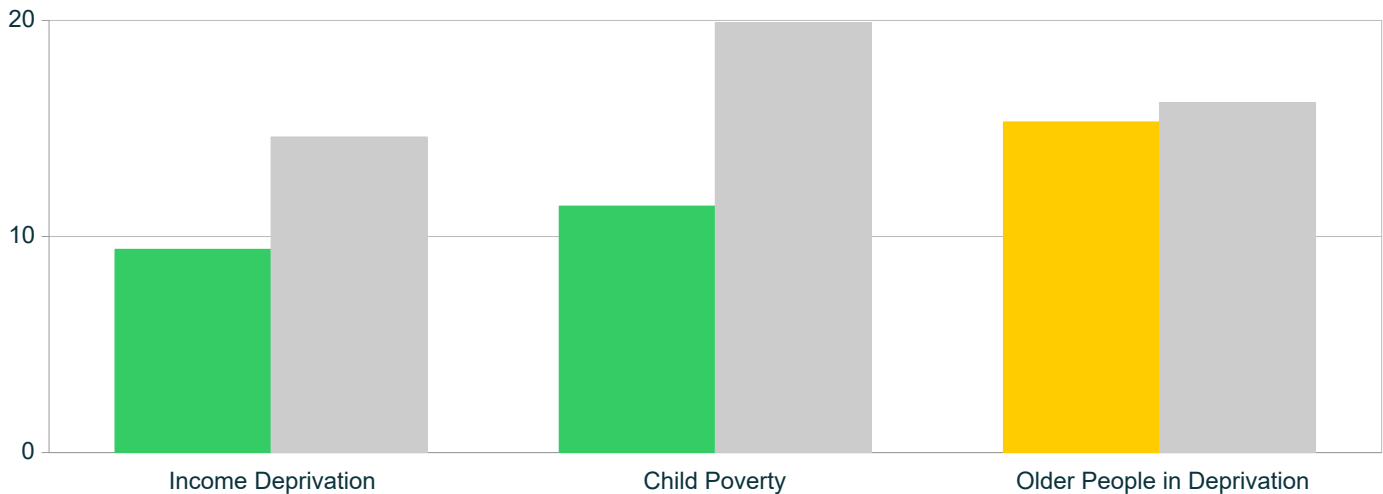

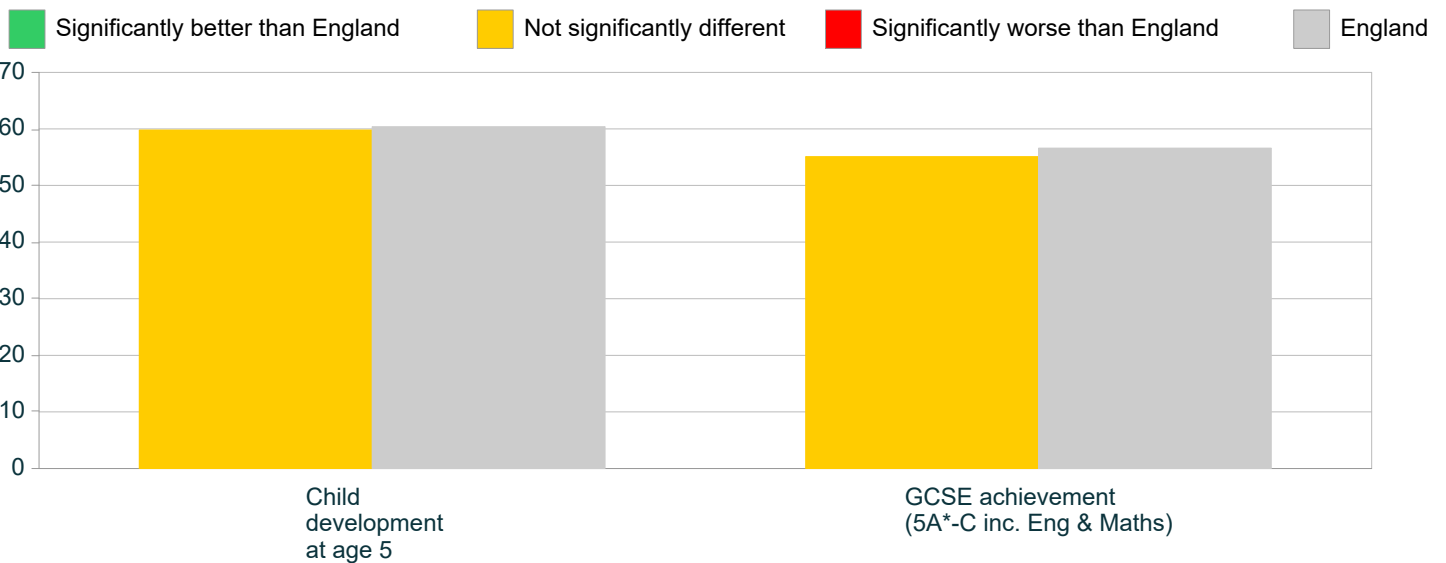

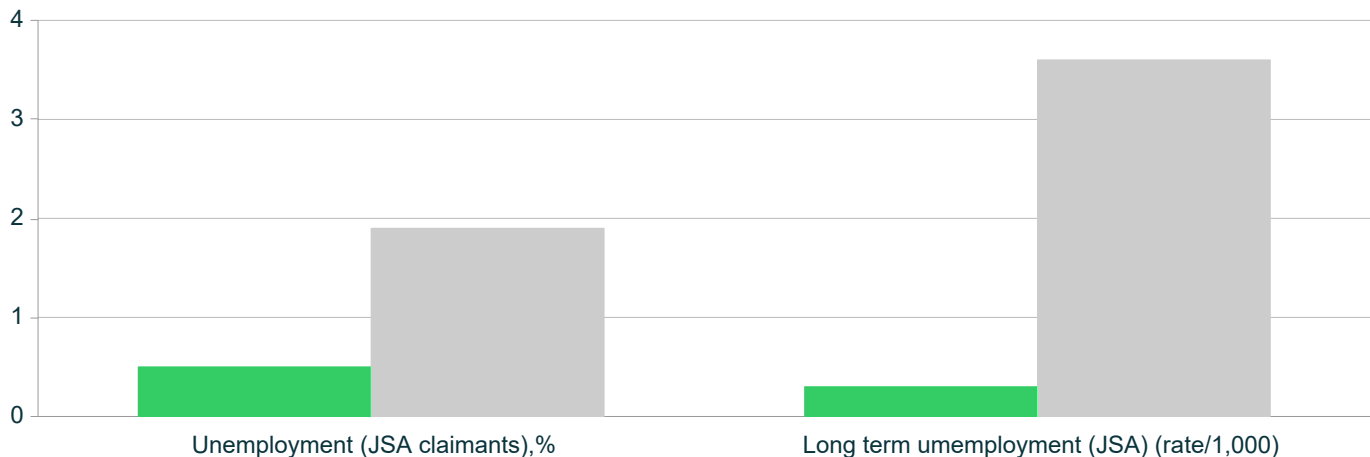

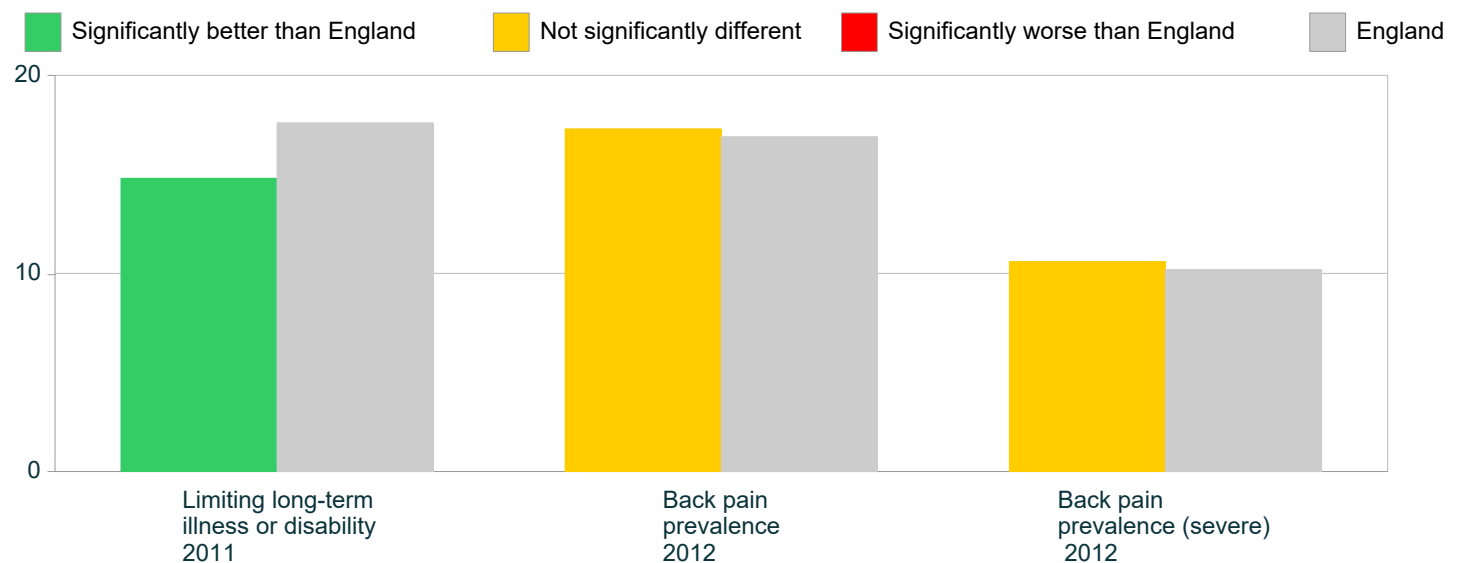

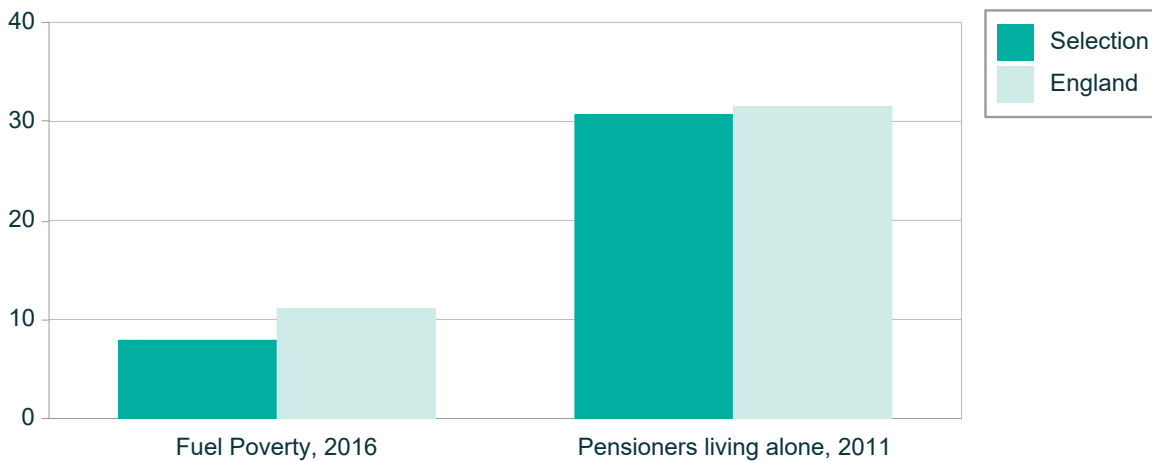

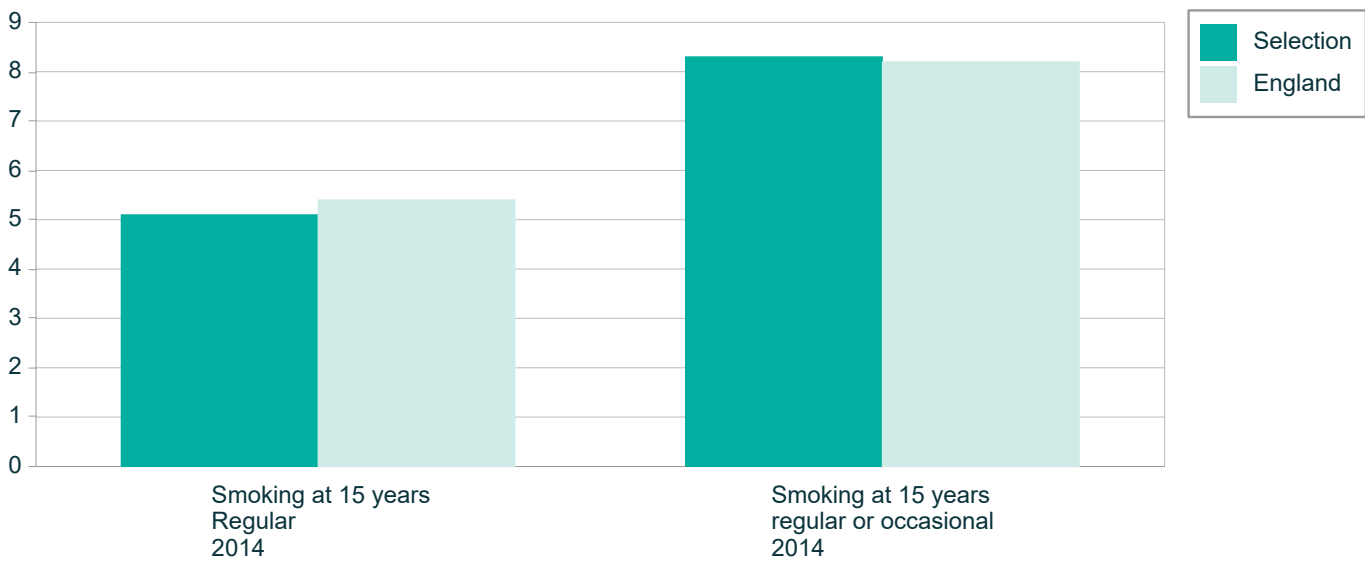

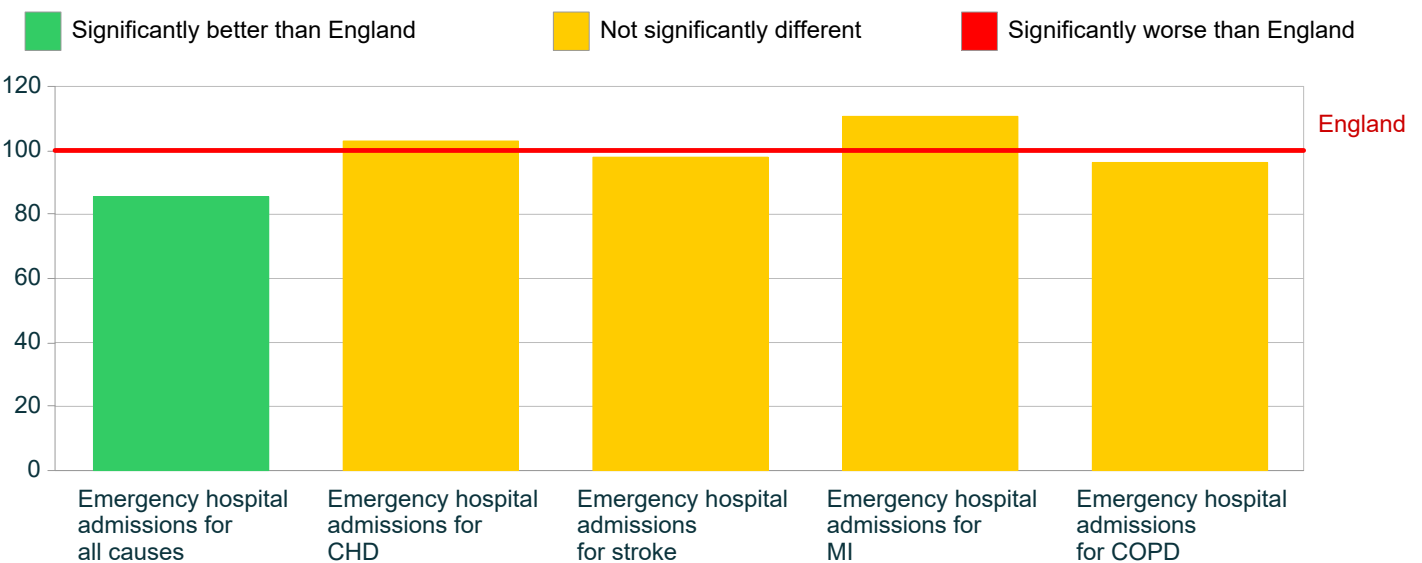

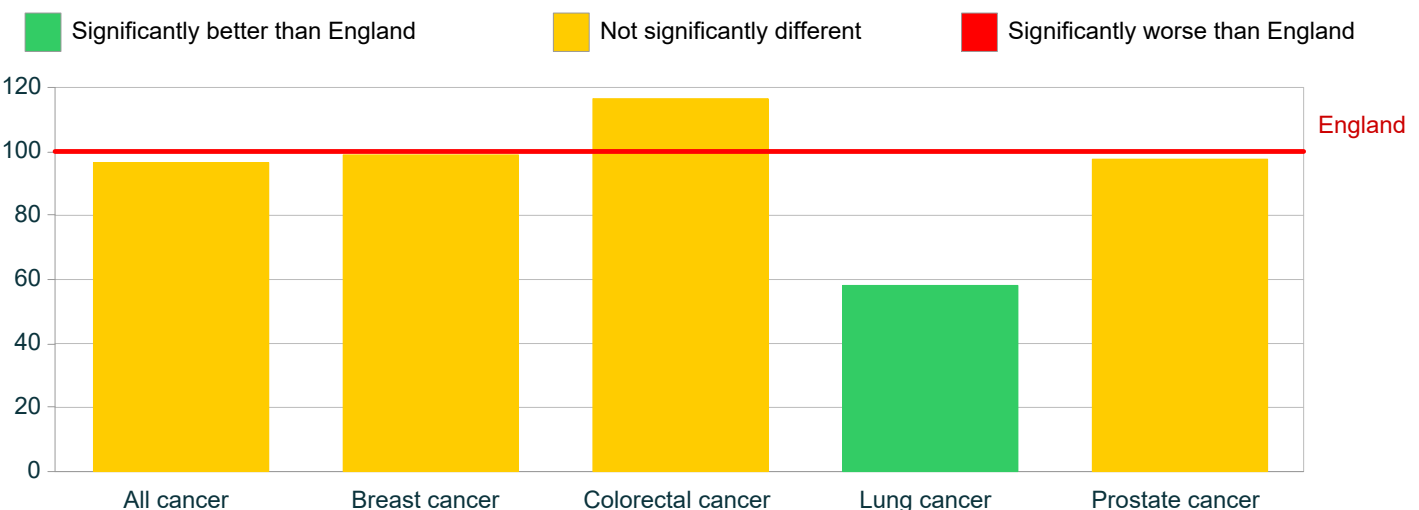

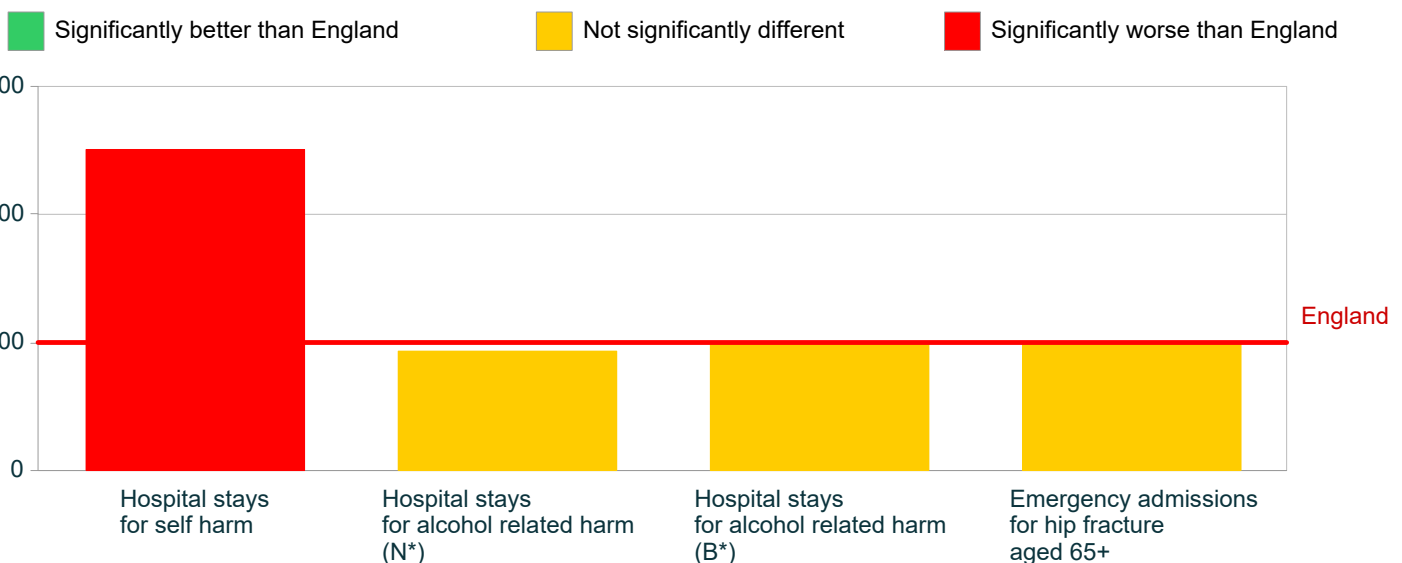

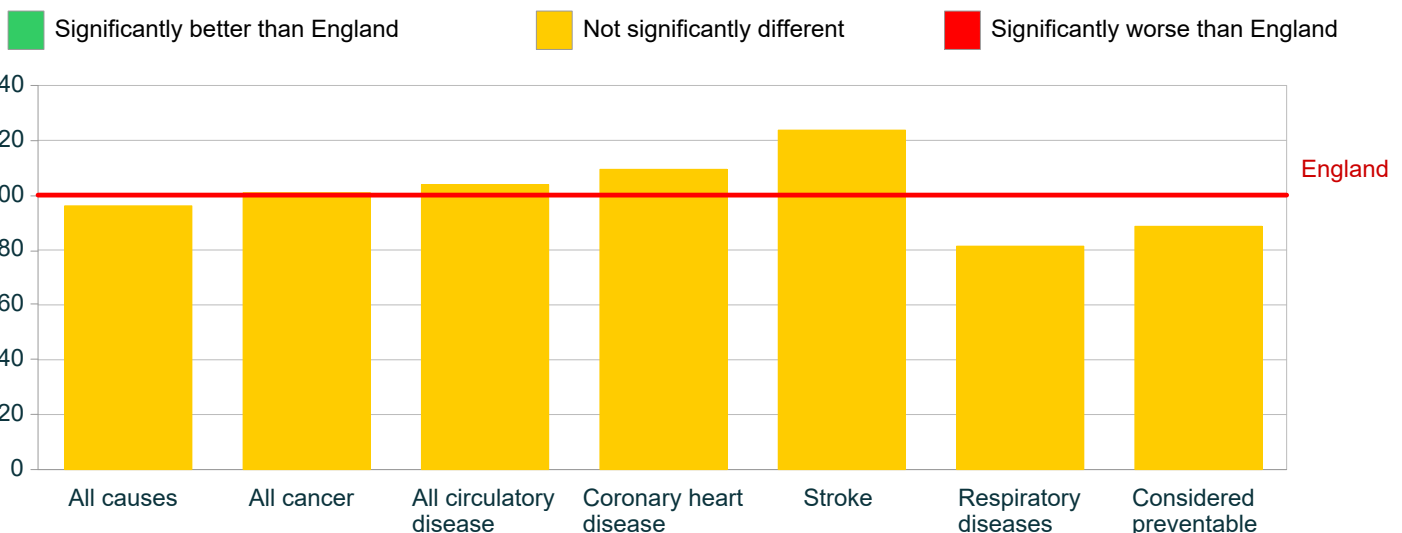

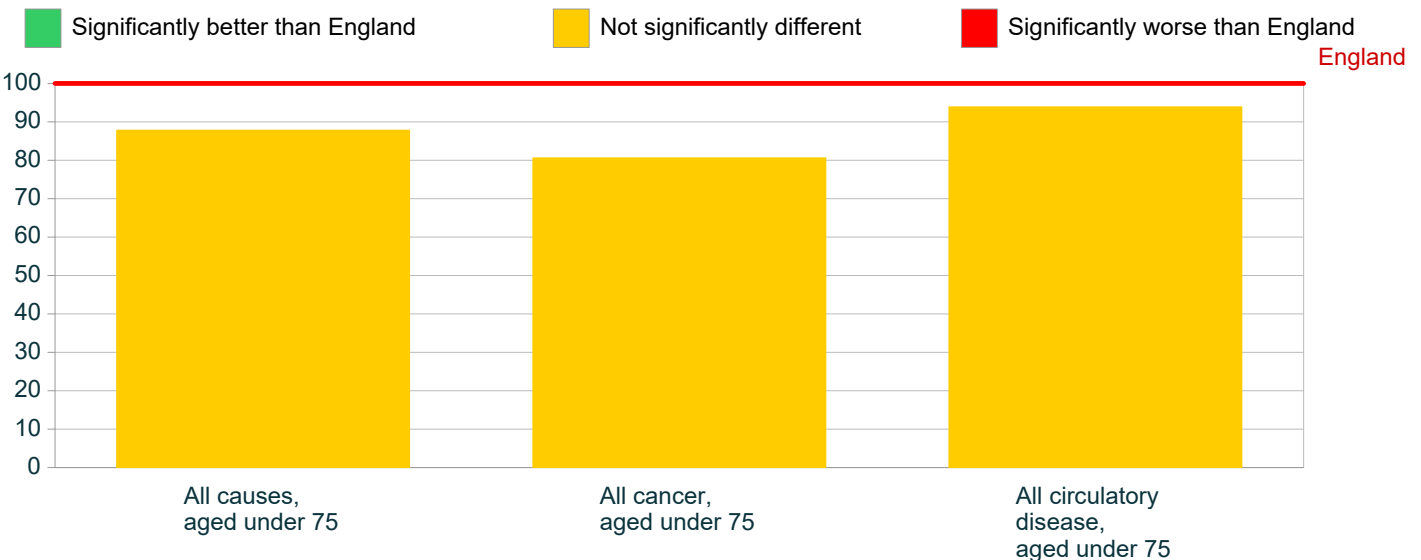
