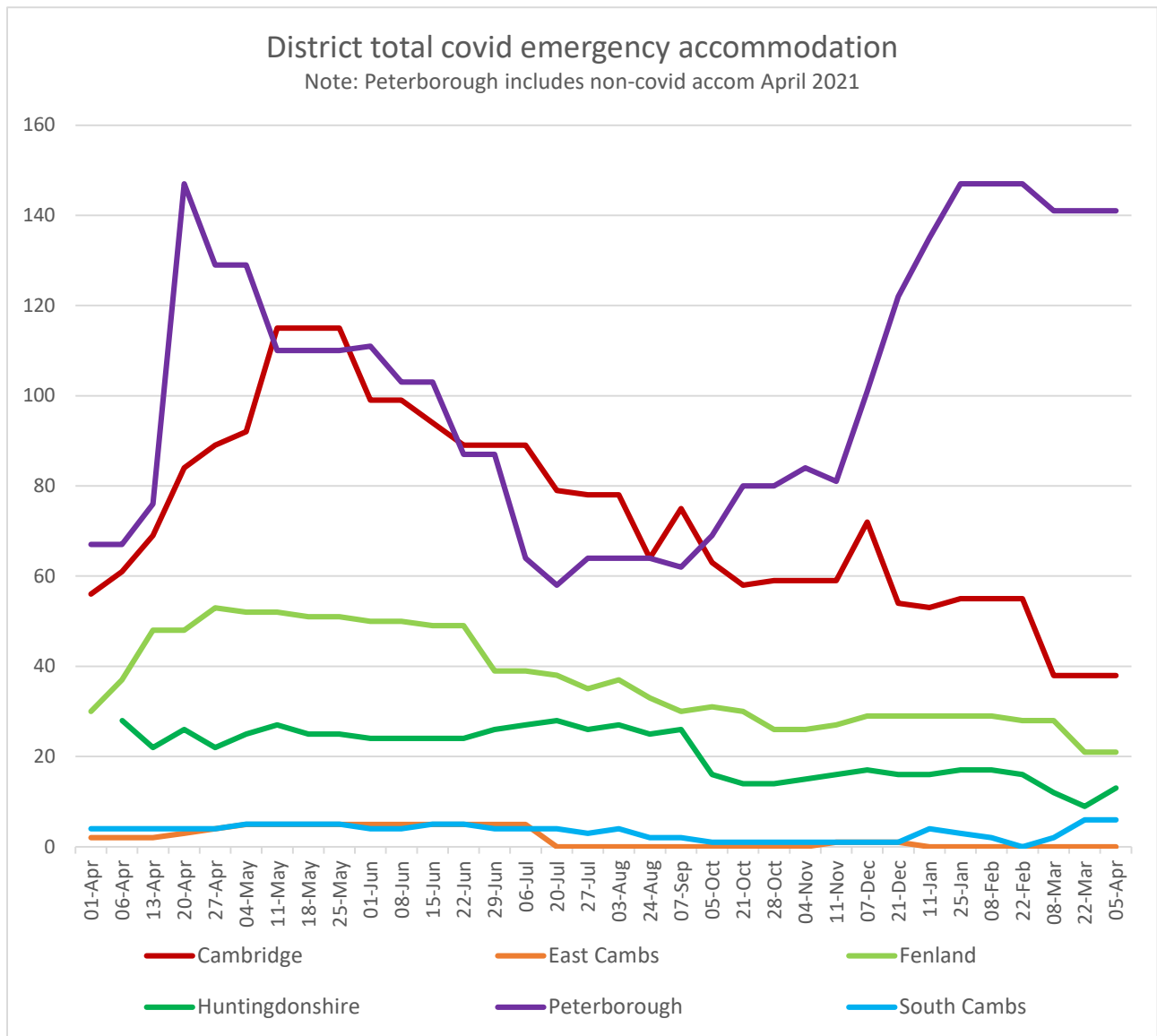

In this table, if I had no update between 2 dates (i.e. some squares would be empty) I've repeated the total provided at the previous update. Otherwise the graph line zigzags up and down reflecting not a change in number of people in accommodation, but whether numbers were submitted every fortnight or not.

Also at April's housing board it became clear Peterborough is adopting a new approach and is not currently separating covid emergency numbers from other homeless temp, so the total looks high in this update but we need to agree, across the area, whether we would like Peterborough to adjust so

they provide the covid only accom (as other districts do) or whether we all want to provide data on all homeless in temp, including covid accommodation.

This will be discussed at the next homelessness strategy meeting if the agenda allows and will update the following housing board meeting.
