

## Co-production inquiries

Our co-production groups will be identifying Inquiry areas which they will explore with partners. The inquiry themes for 2022-23 are



1. Ensure everyone has access to support when accommodated when it is needed, not just at the outset
2. Create a more positive for people experiencing multiple disadvantage in approaching the Council for support with accommodation.
3. Work with the local criminal justice systems to make them more trauma informed so as to better support people suffering from mental ill health

Two further areas; improving access to healthcare treatment and medication; and enabling people who are homeless to be digitally included, are also being investigated.


### Enquiry 1

The group's first inquiry kicked off in September, to ensure everyone has access to support when accommodated when it is needed, not just at the outset. Here are some flipcharts from the first event.

What were people's experiences of moving?



What would "good" look like?



The next stage is to bring together people with lived experiences and stakeholders in the process, to see if everyone can work together to create solutions and recommendations.

**Future Inquiries will include:**

- Promote the Co-Production Group to enable more people with lived experience to have their voice heard
- Challenge stigma faced by those who experience multiple disadvantage
- Ensure everyone has a package of support and accommodation when released from prison
- Ensure DWP advisors have a better understanding of people who are incapacitated because of multiple disadvantage
- No one is discharged from hospital without a safe place to go
- Work, skills and education needs to be more available for people who have experienced multiple disadvantage
- People do not have to re-tell their story over and over again often to people they have never met before
- Create a space for women
- Embed trauma informed care across services in Cambridgeshire

**More co-production groups**
