Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

Is the survey anonymous?

Yes. The responses to questions will not be attributable to you, nor will analysis of your replies allow us to establish who has responded.

Who is this survey for?

We are limiting the survey to our partnership organisations in the Cambridgeshire & Peterborough ICS.

What is it about?

The survey asks about your experience of accessing accommodation as well as about you and your employment. The survey results will help obtain a clearer picture on demand and the range of staff affected.

How is my postcode used?

The survey is anonymous and your postcode will be processed in such a way that it will only be analysed within a geographical area of 1000+ population. The geographic level we undertake analysis at will therefore not be identifiable to any individual house, street or postcode area. By providing your postcode, this will allow us to identify clusters of health and care staff accommodation within the 1000+ population localities to assess where there is potentially need for more housing and supporting infrastructure, transport, public services etc.

Do you have to complete the survey?

The survey is not mandatory, but we would appreciate it if you could complete it.

When should you do it by?

How long will the survey take?

Approx. 20 minutes and most questions provide a series of multiple choice options to choose from.

What happens to your answers?

We treat any information you give us as confidential. It will be collected and analysed by Cambridgeshire & Peterborough ICB on behalf of all participating organisations in the ICS. Organisation specific reports will be provided to enable a local response where possible. We will ensure that no individual can be identified at any time, in any way. Additionally, the findings will be reported to the region's NHSE Accommodation Group, which comprises system representatives and is engaged in developing region-wide solutions to accommodation challenges. This won't help you immediately, but we need this information to identify the best way to help as many staff as possible. By answering the survey questions, we will be able to take discussions further and quicker by drawing on the insights you have provided.
